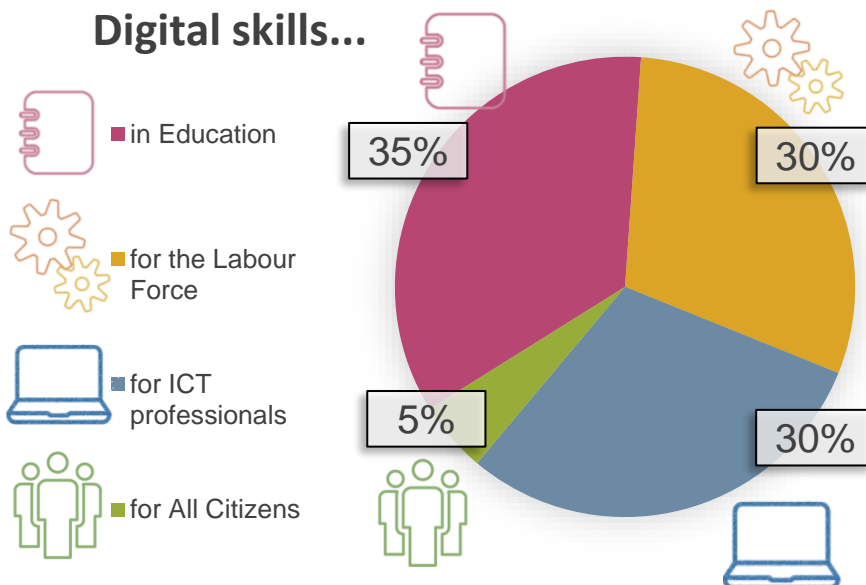

- Launch of the Digital Pedagogy Methodological Centre – a governmental organisation supporting the implementation of the Digital Education Strategy (DES), elaborated with IVSZ in 2016.
- [Digital Labour Force Program](#) (April 2018) – national strategy with detailed actions to close the digital skills gap at each level of the labour market.
- Launch of sectorial skills councils to modernise vocational and adult education to meet digital skills requirements of the labour market.
- Bachelor of Profession in IT – new degree launched at three universities in 2018/2019.
- [Digital Thematic Week](#) – a week dedicated to the deployment of digital pedagogy methods in public education.
