

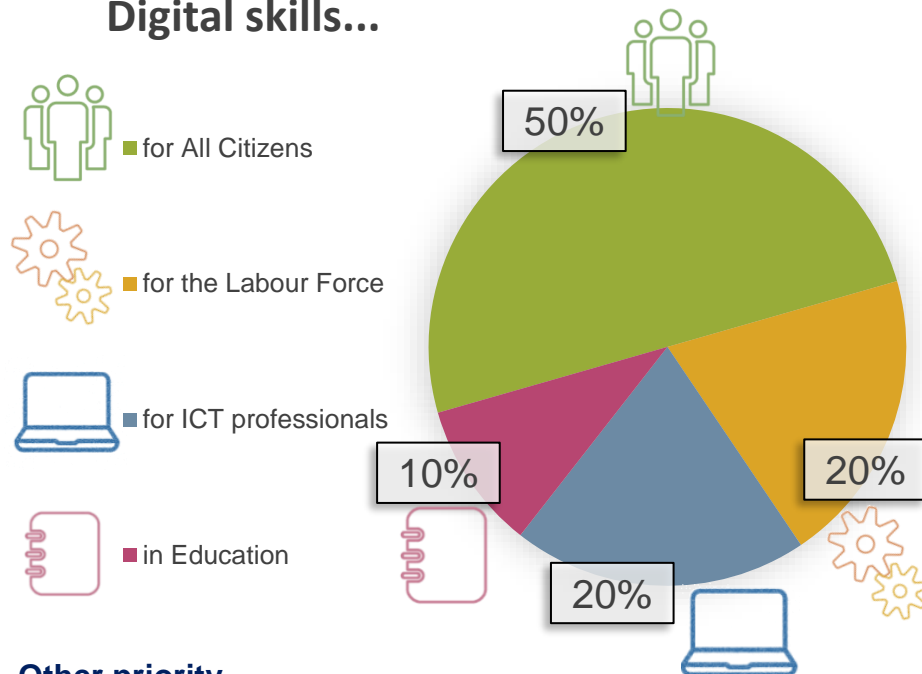


The Lithuanian National Digital Coalition promotes digital skills for life and work, encourages lifelong learning for all, especially young people, to enhance overall digital potential.
