Digital Education Action Plan 2018

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- **Adopted** in January 2018, as part of initiatives supporting the creation of European Education Area.
- **Purpose:** To support Member States and education institutions to adapt to the digital age.
- **Scope: primary, secondary and tertiary levels of formal education**
- **Duration** until the end of 2020

Digital Education Action Plan 2018

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- **Focused approach:** Eleven actions across three priorities:

Priority 1

Making better use of digital technology for teaching and learning

Priority 2

Developing relevant digital competences and skills for the digital transformation

Priority 3

Improving education through better data analysis and foresight

Digital Education Action Plan **Update**: lessons learned and guiding principles

- **More strategic** and **ambitious** approach to digital education
- **Continuity** due to high relevance of current **three priorities**
- **Wider scope**, expanding beyond formal education to non-formal and lifelong learning
- **Longer duration** until 2027
- **Reinforced funding measures**
- **Stronger engagement** with stakeholders
- **Maximised communication** opportunities

Digital Education Action Plan Update

- Update to build on the exiting **three core priorities** with a limited number of ambitious new actions and upscaling of actions from the 2018 Action Plan.
- **Key areas of focus:**
 - Promoting **digital literacy** and **closing the digital skills gap**
 - Fighting **disinformation** and online threats
 - Developing **digital capabilities** in education organisations
 - Making **digital learning** a reality for all (online learning and high-quality online content)
 - Addressing **inclusion, gender** and **regional** digital gap
 - Harvesting (big) **data**, predictive analytics and strategic foresight
