challenges



- Over 40% of Europeans between the ages of 16-74 lack basic digital skills or have insufficient skills.
- Access to ICT and Broadband connection alone will not sufficiently bridge the existing gap.
- Create assisted inclusive and accessible spaces where digital facilitators, operators and trained volunteers , are available for citizens who need information and training in using a computer, surfing the Internet, accessing online public services – the digital literacy aspect.
- No one left behind.

- Access points for people to get support and training, for using digital services.
- Achieving a stronger civic engagement and involving more citizens in the process of co-creation of new services.
- Testbed for new digital services.
