

Privacy statement related to the subscription to newsletters and email alerts

Introduction

 EIOPA, as a European Authority, is committed to protect individuals with regard to the processing of their personal data in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 October 2018 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Regulation (EC) No 45/2001 and Decision No 1247/2002/EC (further referred as "the Regulation").

Purpose of the processing of personal data

- 2. Personal data are processed based on data subject's consent, pursuant to Article 5(1)(d) of the Regulation.
- 3. The legal basis for this processing operation comprises of:

The legal basis for EIOPA's processing of your personal data is your consent. You have expressed this consent when subscribing to receive the information on important developments, activities, events, initiatives, etc., in area of the EIOPA's activities. You can withdraw your consent for these services at any time.

- 4. Personal data collected are processed according to the conditions set out in the above-mentioned Regulation.
- 5. Data will not be used for any purposes other than the performance of the activities specified above.

Controller of the personal data processing

To whom are your data disclosed?

- 9. For the purpose detailed above, access to your personal data is shared with a limited number of EIOPA staff members in the Communication team responsible for the dissemination of material or information, as well as EIOPA staff members responsible for the mailing of thematic newsletters related to the organisation of meetings, workshops, conferences, events, etc, on a need-to-know basis. As the data is stored on the servers of the European Commission's DG Connect, your data is shared with designated staff thereof, on a need-to-know basis.
- 10. Personal data are transmitted in accordance with the relevant provisions of Regulation.
- 11. Please note that pursuant to Article 3(13) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 public authorities (e.g. Court of Auditors, EU Court of Justice) which may receive personal data in the framework of a particular inquiry in accordance with Union or Member State law shall not be regarded as recipients. The further processing of those data by those public authorities shall be compliant with the applicable data protection rules according to the purposes of the processing.

How long are your data kept?

- 12. Your personal data will be retained for as long as you wish to maintain your subscription.
- 13. Files will not be kept beyond the periods specified above unless the personal data is rendered anonymous.

> Transfer of personal data to a third country or international organisation

- 14. No personal data will be transferred to a third country or international organisation.
- Automated decision-making, including profiling
- 15. No automated decision-making, including profiling is performed in the context of this processing operation.

- How can you have access to your data, verify their accuracy, rectify them or object to their processing?
- 16. You have the right to access your personal data, receive a copy of them in a structured and machinereadable format or have them directly transmitted to another controller, as well as request their rectification or update in case they are not accurate.
- 17. You have the right to request the erasure of your personal data, as well as object to or obtain the restriction of their processing.
- 18. You have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data at any time.
- 19. For the protection of your privacy and security, every reasonable step shall be taken to ensure that your identity is verified before granting access, or rectification, or deletion.
