Second quarter of 2016 compared with the first quarter of 2016

Employment up by 0.4% in euro area and by 0.3% in EU28


+1.4% and +1.5% respectively compared with the second quarter of 2015

The number of persons employed increased by 0.4% in the **euro area** (EA19) and by 0.3% in the **EU28** in the second quarter of 2016 compared with the previous quarter, according to national accounts estimates published by **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In the first quarter of 2016, employment increased by 0.4% in both zones. These figures are seasonally adjusted.

Compared with the same quarter of the previous year, employment increased by 1.4% in the **euro area** and by 1.5% in the **EU28** in the second quarter of 2016 (after +1.4% in both zones in the first quarter of 2016).

Eurostat estimates that, in the second quarter of 2016, 232.1 million men and women were employed in the **EU28** (highest level ever recorded); of which 153.3 million were in the **euro area** (highest level since the fourth quarter of 2008). These figures are seasonally adjusted.

These quarterly data on employment provide a picture of labour input consistent with the output and income measure of national accounts.




Employment growth in Member States

Among Member States for which data are available, **Estonia** (+1.7%), **Ireland** (+1.1%) and **Lithuania** (+1.0%) recorded the highest increases in the second quarter of 2016 compared with the previous quarter. A decrease was observed in **Croatia** (-0.4%), while employment remained stable in **Finland**.

Geographical coverage

The **euro area** (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.

Methods and definitions

Employment covers employees and self-employed working in resident production units (i.e. the domestic employment concept). Unless otherwise stated, all employment estimates in this release use *persons* as the measurement unit. ESA2010 acknowledges other possible measures for employment: jobs and total hours worked.
