This project helps the students to recognize that they are a community. At the end of the year Erin Gruwell is allowed to teach her class in the following years too. Erin Gruwell doesn't have any time for her husband, so he divorces from her.

The hero is played by Hilary Swank, she is a charming young woman who tries to help the kids in her class. Her husband is played by Patrick Dempsey. At the beginning he supports his wife but in the end he divorces from her.

Richard LaGravenese won the Humanitas Prize in 2007 and was nominated for the NAACP Image Award in 2008. The soundtrack of this film is rap and black music.

I like the film because it's never boring and I think the film is sad. My favourite scene is where Erin Gruwell plays the game with the red line because it is a very serious scene.
