A FOCUS ON FIVE INVESTMENT PRIORITIES, WHERE THE EU IS BEST PLACED TO DELIVER

Five main objectives will drive EU investments in 2021-2027:



Smarter Europe, through innovation, digitisation, economic transformation and support to small and medium-sized businesses



a **Greener, carbon free Europe**, implementing the Paris Agreement and investing in energy transition, renewables and the fight against climate change



a more **Connected Europe**, with strategic transport and digital networks



a more **Social Europe**, delivering on the European Pillar of Social Rights and supporting quality employment, education, skills, social inclusion and equal access to healthcare



a **Europe closer to citizens**, by supporting locally-led development strategies and sustainable urban development across the EU.

Regional development investments will strongly focus on objectives 1 and 2. 65% to 85% of ERDF and Cohesion Fund resources will be allocated to these priorities, depending on Member States' relative wealth.

• Business incubators and investment support for self-employment, SMEs, business/jobs creation, social innovation and social entrepreneurship.





- Quality and inclusive education and training
- Labour market relevance of Education and training systems
- Lifelong learning, upskilling, anticipating change and new skills requirements

SOCIAL INCLUSION

- Active inclusion
- Integration of migrants and marginalised such as Roma
- Access to services; social protection healthcare systems and long term care
- Social integration of people at risk of poverty;
- Addressing material deprivation

Support to social innovation in ESF+

Social enterprises can be social innovators

- At least one priority per Member State
- Co-financing up to 95%
- For up to 5% of the national ESF+ envelope



Single Market Programme

The Single Market Programme (SMP) is the EU funding programme to help the single market reach its full potential and ensure Europe's recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic.

With €4.2 billion over the period of 2021-2027, it strengthens the single market and supports the competitiveness of enterprises, in particular SMEs, in 14 industrial ecosystems key for recovery and the green and digital transitions.





Single Market Program (2022) Upcoming calls

B2B "Buy Social" Markets

- Promoting sustainable procurement "buy social" practices by companies as well as business partnerships SE & mainstream companies.
- Boost SE's inclusion in economic value chains, boost market access and economic performance.
- Create local partnership to promote buy social markets: chambers of commerce, social economy federations, business schools, public authorities + Transnational component
- Conduct market research, matchmaking, capacity building & training, setup buy social platforms,...
- ✓ Role for local/regional authorities
- ✓ Currently open, DDL: 7/12, Info session: 20/10



Sustainable Responsible Public Procurement (SRPP)

- Enhanced SRPP enabled by the 2017 regulation on Public Procurement.
- This call successes the 2019 call promoting social clauses and sustainable PP
- Two lots:
 - Measuring Positive Impact in Socially Responsible Public Procurement
 - Training and Awareness-raising Activities in Socially Responsible Public Procurement: capacity building civil servants "how to apply" and best practice sharing (awareness, communication, capacity building and training).
- Guide with 71 best practices
- Limited countries and their regions/ localities targeted.
- ✓ Role for local/regional authorities
- ✓ Currently open, DDL: 15/12





Single Market Program (2022) Upcoming calls

Greening the Proximity & Social Economy

- Promoting green transition of P-SE businesses
- Create local partnership to promote green transition: social economy federations, research, incubators, green knowledge hubs, public authorities + <u>Transnational component</u>
- Capacity building, support for green certifications and labels, feasibility studies, energy efficiency analysis and production process assessments, investment opportunities, awareness and training).
- ✓ Role for local/regional authorities
