



Implementing circular systemic solutions in cities and regions

Session as part of the European Week of Regions and Cities 2022

Information Session – 13th October 2022, 12:30–13:30

On 13 October, the European Commission's DG Research and Innovation hosted an info session on '**Implementing circular systemic solutions in cities and regions**'. The interactive session brought together more than 80 participants, including local and regional authorities, businesses and academia. The Circular Cities and Regions Initiative (CCRI) Coordination and Support Office explained the technical and cooperation support they will provide to cities and regions in the coming years for implementing their circular systemic solutions. While Asker Municipality (CCRI Pilot) focuses on making their construction sector circular, the representative of the Region of Central Macedonia (CCRI Fellow) highlighted their actions for addressing circularity in solid waste management. Participants identified knowledge exchange and expert support as the main needs to accelerate their transition to circular economy, which confirms the relevance of CCRI activities for facilitating cooperation between cities, regions and knowledge providers, offering technical and financial support, and analysing research and innovation gaps in circular economy.
