


The Swedish ESF Council



The European pillar of social rights/social sustainability







Transnational cooperation ESF+ 2021-2027

Article 15 - Regulation (EU) 2021/1057 ESF+

Member States may support measures for transnational cooperation within the framework of one of the specific objectives stated in Article 4.1 a–l.
