# Embrace environmental transparency

New Challenges for  
Europe's Cohesion

Nature-relevant insights from 2022 (110 European Cities)

**68%**

of European cities are facing risks to public health or health systems associated with climate change (and 32% do not know or do not answer)

**87%**

of 155 Climate Risk and Vulnerability Assessments declared by European Cities consider factors other than 'Assessment considers nature' or 'Environment, Biodiversity and forestry'. **Only 13%**

**48%**

of European cities adaptation measures are "Ecosystem-based actions" (incl. green infrastructure, ecological restoration, increase biological diversity, afforestation & reforestation, community-based natural resource management, adaptive land-use management)

Only **8%**

of European cities declared mitigation actions aiming at increasing green space and/or biodiversity

Only **5%**

of Europe cities monitor biodiversity as an adaptation action
