



## **Briefly about Interreg**




- Interreg = European Territorial Cooperation
- Part of the EU's Cohesion Policy
- Interreg supports cooperation across borders through project funding. Its aim is to jointly tackle common challenges and find shared solutions.
- Interreg enables bottom-up solutions that contribute to achieving common goals, e.g. the EU's Territorial Agenda 2030, the EU Green Deal, and in the case of the NPA, the EU Arctic Policy.



## Better cooperation governance

- Become better at making use of cooperation opportunities.
- ✓ Engage with underrepresented groups e.g. YOUNG people, indigenous people.

#### How does it work?

- Open competitive call for projects on a regular basis
- Promoted and scheduled on NPA website
- Regional networks of RCPs
- Project development support
- MC decisions within 3 months of closing of call





# What are the conditions for participating?

New Challenges for Europe's Cohesion

#### Transnational partnership

- NPA Programme partner countries at least one of which is from an EU Member State.
- Partnerships of least 2 of the 3 geographical zones of the programme area: Finland-Sweden-Norway; Ireland; Faroe Islands-Greenland-Iceland for main projects.
- Project idea rooted in the needs of the area and based on priorities and specific objectives of the NPA
- Engaged end-user from both public and private sectors





#### What can be done?



#### Types of **projects**

- Main all priorities and transnational partnership
- Small scale to strengthen organisational capacity in NPA communities – Priority 3 only
- Preparatory projects all priorities ongoing.
  - Clustering and bridging
  - Partnership of minimum 2 partners one must be NPA EU state





#### What can be done?



#### Types of actions

- Tailored to needs in the programme area and taken up or up-scaled by organisations. Actions jointly developed such as:
  - Strategies and action plans
  - Pilot actions developed jointly and implemented in projects
  - Jointly developed solutions

- **Open currently** is the 2<sup>nd</sup> call for projects in all priorities and closes December 5<sup>th</sup> with decision by MC March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2023.

- 2<sup>nd</sup> preparatory call is planned to be launched February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Main project call is planned to be launched April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023
