Performance framework - basics

- Performance framework is about implementing the programme efficiently and the way it has been planned.
- It will not answer the impact question, because you may achieve the targets set in the performance framework, but still have no results.
- There will be rewarded for getting it right, but there may be as well a penalty for getting it very wrong.

Performance framework – in action

- No official reporting on performance framework so far, but review of progress to feature in the agenda of monitoring committees.
- AIR submitted in 2017 will be the first to report on progress towards milestones and targets.
- Geo desks to pay attention to the potential implementation weaknesses and to clarify instances of low performance in their observations.

Performance framework – amendments

- Amendments adopted for 28 OPs and submitted via SFC for 7 more.
- These are due mostly to the changes in allocation (19), but there are also some technical errors (2) or other due justifications (6).
- Only incidentally requests were justified by incorrect assumptions.
