The Commission proposes **Cohesion's Action for Refugees in Europe (CARE)**, allowing Member States and regions to provide emergency support to people fleeing from Russia's invasion of Ukraine.

Flexibility in spending

CARE introduces the necessary flexibility in the 2014-2020 Cohesion policy rules and extends the 100% EU co-financing rate for one more year. CARE also allows a swift reallocation of available funding to such emergency support.
