RURAL AREA INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY BROADBAND NETWORK (RAIN)

ERDF: EUR 15 519 784 81 - 09/2005 - 08/2008 - Sector: broadband network



During the implementation of the project, 3357 kilometres of fibre-optic cable lines were laid and 509 RAIN network units were installed, connecting all Lithuanian rural elders (467) to 51 municipalities, and 330 schools were also connected to fibre-optic infrastructure. The total scope of this technological and connectivity oriented project covers 300 000 residents in the country's rural areas (i.e. about 10% of Lithuanian people!). The project is very future oriented and was set up in a way that would allow potential improvements and increase the speed without many additional costs. The RAIN project was entered in the Golden Book of the World Summit on the Information Society.
