

#EUinmyregion 2020 “Postcards”

Rules

All types of EU-funded projects can participate (ERDF, ESF, Interreg, Life, Creative Europe etc.)

A participant / project / managing authority can send several pictures of the same project (maximum five), **but only one picture per project will be selected.**

Not all of the pictures received will be printed. A maximum of 25 winning photos per month (150 in total) will be selected. All participants will be notified about the result of the selection on their own part.

If your photo is selected, you will be contacted through email and asked to provide your address and other information that might be necessary to contact you. Please allow a few weeks between the award notification and the postcards receipt.

Regardless of the results of the selection, your photo may be used in the communication materials of the European Commission.

Selection of photos:

Photos will be selected based on aesthetic considerations, appropriateness, audience appeal.

The **minimum requirements for the quality of the photo** must also be met for it to be printed.

Quality of the picture

The quality of picture should be **minimum 1000 pixels** or **minimum 150 dpi**.

Project description

The project description should be **no longer than 30 words**, including the **name, short description, the budget, the EU financing**, and **website/social media channel** for more information.

The description can be provided in English or in the national language. Please note the description will be printed in the submitted format. No translation or formatting of the text is foreseen.

Copyright and data protection

All entries must be original work and the participant must either own all copyrights or have obtained all the appropriate authorisations from the holders of copyrights.

By entering the contest, participants retain full copyright of their images and text. Participants grant the European Commission a non-exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide licence for the entire duration of the copyrights, to use, store, reproduce, modify, create derivative works, print, publish, communicate to the public or otherwise make publicly available, in any format, medium and language, whether in print or electronically the submitted pictures. The European Commission is permitted to license the

rights listed above to third parties for the purposes of promoting the pictures in publications, social media, events and media. No fee will be payable by the European Commission for this use.

Participants warrant that the use of the rights licensed do not and will not infringe the rights of any third party and agree to hold harmless the European Commission from and against copyright infringement claims.

Participants must obtain written consent from any individual aged 18 or above who are identifiable in the picture. Participants taking a photograph of anyone under 18 must ensure that they obtain the written consent of that child's parent/guardian. The consent must cover the use of the picture by the European Commission as described above.

It is the participants' responsibility to ensure that the necessary authorization has been obtained. Participants must retain all release forms obtained as they may be asked to prove that consent has been given. Download the release form [here](#).
