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REACT-EU Fostering crisis repair and resilience

1. What is REACT-EU?

The **Recovery Assistance for Cohesion and the Territories of Europe** initiative, or simply "REACT-EU", constitutes additional EU budget resources financed by the EU Recovery Plan - **NextGenerationEU**. REACT-EU provides **€50.6 billion** (current prices) of fresh resources to existing cohesion policy programmes for the years 2021 and 2022. It **aims to bridge the gap** between the immediate emergency response in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic and its social consequences, and long-term recovery.

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2021-2027 Cohesion policy EU budget allocations

Following the entry into force on 1 July 2021 of the 2021-2027 Cohesion policy legislative framework the Commission adopted decisions on the breakdown of the EU budget allocations by country and EU fund on 5 July, 2021.

The financial allocations (current prices) are presented below showing the EU allocations to different cohesion policy "goals", Member States and EU Funds in a series of interactive charts.

The initial national allocations will be translated into detailed investment plans through the formalisation of national partnership agreements and the detailed national and regional programmes.

- **Publish the adopted 2021-2027 programmes with an initial focus on plans adopted**
- **Coverage**
 - Shared management funds managed by DGs REGIO EMPL AGRI MARE - ERDF-CF-JTF-ESF+-CAP-EMFAF
 - Extension to DG HOME funds – AMIF-BMVI-ISF
- **Priority to common elements across funds**
- **Progressively expand the data to monitor implementation**
