### Legal Framework for Partnership

- Article 11 of the Treaty on European Union to maintain an open, transparent and regular dialogue with representative associations and civil society
- White Paper from the Commission entitled "European Governance" (COM(2001) 428 final, 25.7.2001)
- European Code of Conduct on Partnership: Delegated Regulation EU (No 240/2014) applicable for 2014-2020 and 2021-2027
- Common Provisions Regulation (CPR): Article 8 of Regulation (EU)
   2021/1060 of the European Parliament and of the Council on Partnership and multi-level governance

### ESF+ provisions for partnership

- ESF+ recital 28
- ESF+ article 9
- 1. MS to ensure "meaningful participation of the social partners and CSOs in the delivery of employment, education and social inclusion policies supported by the ESF+ strand under shared management";
- 2. An "appropriate amount" of ESF+ under shared management in each programme to capacity building of the social partners and civil society organisations (eg. "training, networking measures, and strengthening of the social dialogue, and to activities jointly undertaken by the social partners")

In MS with Country Specific Recommendations in the field: 0.25%

- Partnership for innovation "public authorities, social partners, social enterprises, private sector, and civil society" (ESF+ art. 14)
- European Code of Conduct on Partnership (ECCP): continues to apply

# European Community of Practice on Partnership 2021-2027

- Set out in Art. 18 the European Code of Conduct on Partnership (ECCP) in the Commission Delegated Regulation no 240/2014 (the regulation continues to apply during the 2021-2027 period)
- Builds on the experiences of the community under ESF Transnational Cooperation Platform that existed in 2015-2019
- will involve all 2021-27 Common Provision Regulation and Common Agriculture Policy funds:
  - > CPR funds: ERDF/CF/JTF, ESF+, AMIF/ISF/BMVI, EMFAF
  - > EAGF/EAFRD





#### What will the ECoPP do?

The community's tasks shall be to:

- Facilitate exchange of experience with regard to partnership;
- Stimulate capacity building;
- Disseminate relevant outcomes, in particular good practice and innovative approaches;
- Review the application and functioning of the European Code of Conduct and prepare proposals for its possible update
- Annual plenary meetings are envisaged the first planned for early 2022
- Subgroups on key issues (made up of MAs and other stakeholders)opportunities to discuss Fund-specific issues and focus on implementation of the
  partnership principle

### Composition of the ECoPP:

#### 200 members

81 representatives of MAs (3 per MS)

119 partners
(among those stipulated in Art 8 CPR)

Nominated from MAs/Coordination Authorities

Selection through Open Call for Applications

 COM published an open Call for Applications and will select Article 8 members (balanced representation vis-à-vis geographical coverage, fund specific representation and categories of stakeholders)

#### **The Just Transition Platform (JTP)**

- Assist all stakeholders in accessing JTM support
- High-level JTP events help to:
  - share knowledge and good practices
  - support capacity-building and exchanges across sectors
  - provide advice on just transition to authorities and stakeholders involved in JTM-related activities
- Dedicated webpage with helpdesk and database of projects and experts
- Working groups for carbon intensive-regions
- Link to Coal Regions in Transition initiative (dedicated work stream for coal, peat, oil shale regions)





#### JTF in carbon-intensive regions

- The transition to a climate-neutral Europe in 2050 will not only affect coal regions or declining sectors
- Sectors with high carbon-intensity are expected to undergo significant transformation
  - > for instance steel, metals, cement, chemicals...
- JTF will support territories that are heavily **dependent on carbon- intensive industries**...
- ... and that experience a negative impact from the transition by 2030 or before, such as:
  - > social impacts, linked to unemployment or needs for reskilling
  - > economic impacts, linked to changes in production patterns
  - > demographic, health or environmental impacts



#### Addressing knowledge gaps

- What are the pathways of carbon-intensive industries, and which impacts will this have in EU regions?
  - Calculations of regional employment impact of EU ETS installations (<a href="https://europa.eu/!nkXRqB">https://europa.eu/!nkXRqB</a>)
  - Regional industrial transitions to climate neutrality: sectors, locations and socio-economic impacts (ongoing study by OECD)
- How can we make sure that this transition happens in a fair way?
  - Working Groups on carbon-intensive regions
  - Knowledge capitalisation work of the Just Transition Platform
