

an appropriate amount	0.25% of national ESF+ allocation




# Programming capacity building for social partners and civil society


Programming under all specific objectives (except SO m) on material deprivation)

Activities such as training, networking measures, and strengthening of the social dialogue, and to activities jointly undertaken by the social partners...



#### Capacity building for social partners in ESF+






> 0.4% of the ESF+ total planned amount





Capacity building for social partners by specific objective
