



What is #Youth4Regions?

Context: relatively low awareness of the policy in some countries (2017).

A programme to enable a generation of journalists specialized in EU cohesion policy.

Objectives:

- Enable aspiring journalists to specialize in EU cohesion policy
- Create a pan-European community of journalists
- Fight disinformation
- Enhance the links between the European Commission and young Europeans



Who can apply

- Citizens of EU Member States, EU neighbouring or candidate countries
- Between 18 and 30 years old
- Demonstrate a real interest in journalism through studies and/or work experience



How it works?

- Application period: 11 April 11 July
- During the EU Regions Week:
 - > Trainings
 - Mentorship
 - Practical experience in the pressroom
 - Visit of media organisations and other EU institutions
- After the Week:
 - DG REGIO media programmes
 - Youth4Regions alumni network



Previous editions

- Participants become part of the Youth4Regions Alumni community
- 134 alumni after 5 editions
- We hold regular alumni chats with guest speakers
