



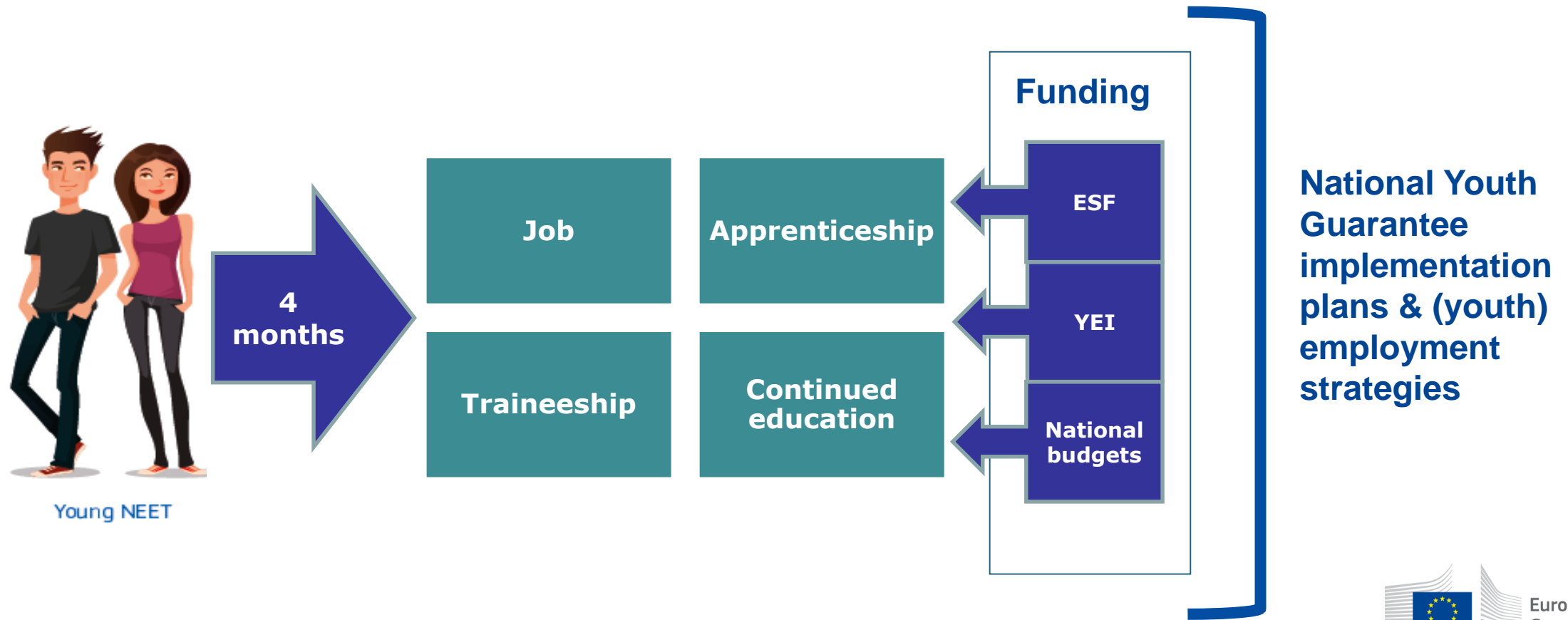

All young people up to the age of [25] should receive a good quality offer of:

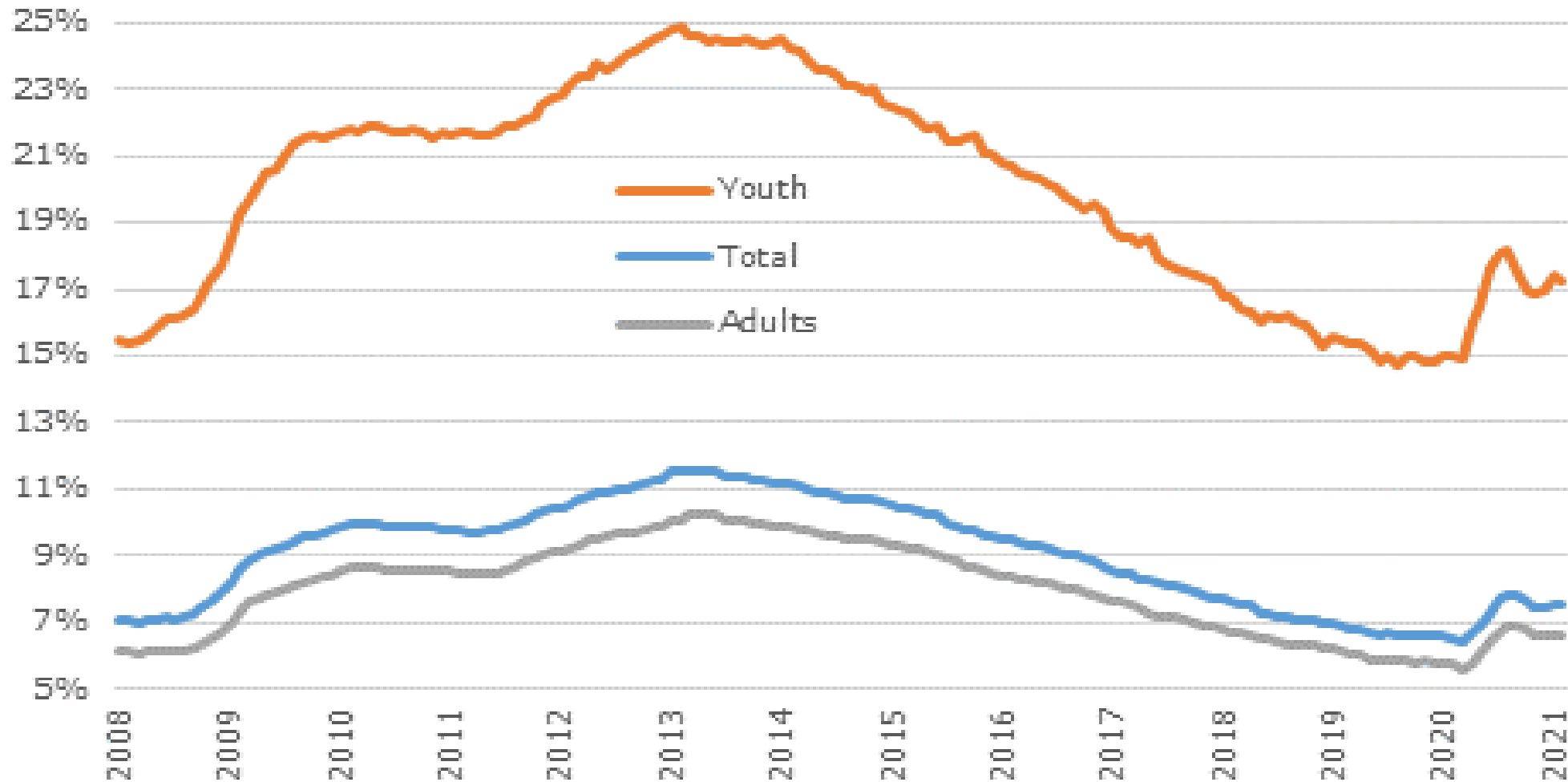

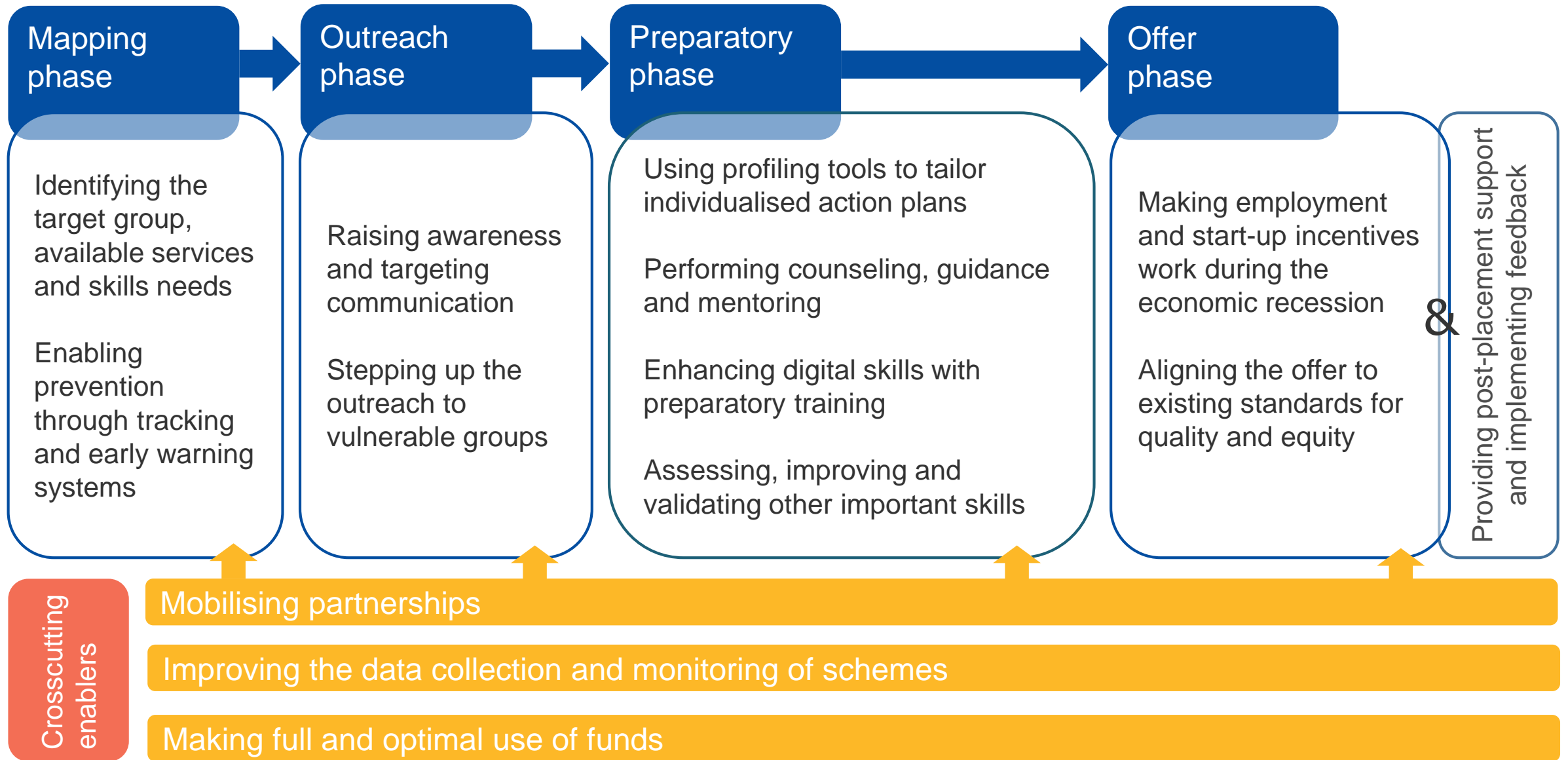
