A knowledge management platform aimed at capturing and visualising projects described in list of operations for 2021-2027 programmes

The pilot and the project

- After the final round of internal validations in April, Kohesio was approved from a pilot to a fully-fledged project.
- Now, Kohesio is being set up as the single entry point for Cohesion policy data for 2021-2027.
- First step: capturing CF, ERDF and ESF data for the 2014-2020 programming period and for all MS.










Communication, transparency, visibility

- Communicate the impact of European policies at territorial level
- Increase understanding of all EU policies in a MS
- Increase transparency of EU funding in a systemic way
- Overcome language barriers






Communication, transparency, visibility

- Increase use of social media in promoting specific projects
- Involve projects and beneficiaries into the "wider picture"
- Address media inquiries
- Showcase and increase reach of projects' achievements






Programme and project management

- Make project data available at a click or two






Evaluate territorial distribution of funding in a given area

- Integrate data about projects with audiovisual material and communication campaigns








Capitalizing the lists of operations



A look back to 2014-2020....







...and a leap forward to 2021-2027.

Our approach for addresing the list of operations requirement in 2021-2027 is twofold:

- A support tool to make it simple and
- A knowledge management platform to bring new content.





- A manual and template.
- Consists of a list of data fields, including <u>mandatory and essential ones</u> too, and descriptions, formats and examples..
 - Unique ID
 - Audio-visual material
 - •
- To foster harmonization across MS.



- A knowledge base to capitalize.
- By reusing the harmonized LoO datasets, Kohesio will create better transparency and visibility of Cohesion policy operations.



Why use it?

- ...to improve accuracy, reliability and quality of Cohesion policy data.
- ...to share country-specific knowledge and provide added value to CPR requirements.
- ...to bring Cohesion policy closer to citizen's understanding.
- ...to support standardization and harmonisation of the data.
- ...to meet CPR requirements.
- ...to contribute to a ready-to-use, EU-level knowledge base on Cohesion policy.
