

Why YouTube?

- Video repository
 - Virtually free and unlimited storage capability
 - Ease-of-use
 - Smooth integration with other platforms
 - Low-risk

- Search Engine Optimisation
 - "the process of improving the quality and quantity of website traffic to a website or a web page from search engines"
 - YouTube is owned by Google and highly integrated with the search
 - Free



How to upload videos?



How to upload?

- Details
 - Complete title / description (and chapters)
 - Custom thumbnail if possible
 - Playlists are useful
 - It's probably not for kids.

- Video elements
 - Subtitles?
 - Always add an end screen
 - Add cards for more customisation

- Visibility
 - Public
 - Private / Unlisted
 - Schedule
 - Premiere



• Tags

Channel Customization



Channel customisation

- Layout
 - Channel trailer / Featured video
 - Featured sections

- Branding
 - Picture
 - Banner (check multiple devices)
 - Watermark

- Basic info
 - As much information as possible.
 - SEO again.







Analytics

- Dashboard
 - Most important info at one glance.
- Channel analytics
 - Overview
 - Reach
 - Engagement
 - Audience

- Advanced mode
 - All of the above +
 much more
 - Exports readily available



Additional Functions



- Social functions
 - Posts
 - Polls
 - Shorts

- YT Creator Academy
 - Free online courses that are actually good.
