Timeline

- Applications to be submitted by 9 May 2021 23:59:59 CET
- The jury meets in July
- The finalists will be announced late August/early September
- Finalists invited for a training ("Pitch your project" and "video editing") as part of EU Regions
 Week 11-14 October
- Finalists requested to produce a video during September October
- Vote for the Public choice award: September to mid-November
- Award ceremony with the announcement of winners to take place 2 December in Dubrovnik

Five areas - crucial part of the EU's regional policy:

- SMART Europe: Increasing the competitiveness of local businesses in a digital world
- GREEN Europe: Green and resilient communities in urban and rural setting
- FAIR Europe: Fostering inclusion and anti-discrimination
- URBAN Europe: Promoting green, sustainable and circular food systems in functional urban areas
- TOPIC OF THE YEAR: Enhancing green mobility in the regions: European Year of Rail 2021





Category 1: SMART EUROPE

Increasing the competitiveness of local businesses in a digital world

- The EU committed to become a global digital player
- SMEs, as the backbone of EU economy, have a pivotal role in this



Category 1: SMART EUROPE

Increasing the competitiveness of local businesses in a digital world

We look for projects that demonstrate innovation in terms of:

- Reducing CO2 emissions with new business processes
- Contributing to relevant RIS 3
- Increasing presence in non-EU market
- Creating jobs in digital industries





Category 2: GREEN Europe Green and resilient communities in urban and rural setting

- The European Green Deal as a path way to a sustainable transition:
 - a new growth strategy for a transformed, resourceefficient and competitive economy,
 - avoiding net emissions of greenhouse gases
 - decoupling economic growth from resource use,
 - no person and no place is left behind
- A key for meeting these targets: how we reconstruct our cities – buildings, settlements, blue and green spaces, transport and energy infrastructure networks



Category 2: GREEN Europe

Green and resilient communities in urban and rural setting

Projects should demonstrate innovation in terms of:

- reducing CO2 per year through energy efficiency in the built environment, including transport networks,
- increase energy efficiency in buildings
- contributing to climate change mitigation and adaptation
- Impacting positively on social inclusion and cohesion through green measures
- creating jobs in green industries





Category 3: **FAIR Europe**Fostering inclusion and antidiscrimination

- EU is taking huge efforts in combating discrimination of any kind and enhancing the equality of treatment of all Europeans, including gender equality, integration of migrants, and the accessibility for disabled persons
- We are looking for good projects that contribute to a more inclusive society at large, and nondiscrimination of any person.



Category 3: **FAIR Europe**Fostering inclusion and anti-discrimination

Projects should demonstrate innovation in terms of:

- Fostering active inclusion of persons at risk of discrimination
- Easing the reintegration of disadvantaged persons in the labour market
- contributing to gender equality and diversity through management strategies
- creating jobs in course of integration work and anti-discrimination efforts





Category 4: URBAN Europe

Promoting green, sustainable and circular food systems in functional urban areas

- Resilient food systems are fundamentally important for biodiversity, natural resources and health.
- EU is committed to make food systems sustainable by identifying and implementing new opportunities for the operators in the food value chain.
- Farm to Fork Strategy: food safety, animal and plant health and effective internal market.
- Reduction of food waste at every stage of the value chain.
- European cities and their surroundings are leading urban food systems transformations.



Category 4: URBAN Europe

Promoting green, sustainable and circular food systems in functional urban areas

Projects should demonstrate innovation in terms of:

- fostering cooperation between urban and rural stakeholders
- contributing to the reduction of CO₂ emissions per year through food waste collection and green solutions in supply chain management
- impacting positively on rural or coastal communities in the urban functional area
- creating jobs in local food industries





TOPIC OF THE YEAR

Enhancing green mobility in the regions: European Year of Rail 2021

- 2021 is the European Year of Rail, as it marks the first full year in which the rules agreed under the Fourth Railway Package will be implemented throughout the EU.
- Rail is the only mode of transport to have almost continuously reduced its CO2 emissions since 1990, at the same time as it increased transport volumes.



TOPIC OF THE YEAR

Enhancing green mobility in the regions: European Year of Rail 2021

Projects shall demonstrate innovation in terms of:

- impacting positively on local and regional mobility, in particular in areas that affect passengers directly
- contributing to regional mobility development plans
- reducing CO2 emissions per year through mobility measures
- enhancing multi-modality by linking rail solutions to other green mobility modes.





Cross-cutting Criteria

In an effort to bring Europe closer to the citizens the selection of projects will also consider citizen engagement and empowerment strategies, with a special attention paid to youth involvement.

The Regiostars Jury thus will examine projects against their **design and implementation** allowing for citizen's participation or allowing for bottom-up approaches that involve local communities.





Eligibility Criteria

- Application submitted via the online platform by 9 May 2021, 23:59:59 CET.
- Applications must be in one of the official EU languages.
- Application includes an endorsement letter of the managing authority
- Application refers to a project, which has received EU co-financing from the European
 Cohesion Policy Funds, or a project which has received EU funding under Interreg IPA-CBC
 or Interreg ENI-CBC programmes, starting earliest at 1 January 2007.
- The project clearly refers to one of the five award categories of 2021.
- The project should be either fully implemented or should be in a sufficiently mature state for the jury to assess it



REGIOSTARS **Award Criteria**

Award Criteria

- Innovative character of the project in the selected award category
- Good results and impact of the project in relation to its initial objectives and regional context
- Financial sustainability of the project
- Transferability and possibility to replicate the project in other regions, especially lesser developed ones
- Meaningful citizen engagement & involvement during its design and/or implementation with a special attention to young people

- When to apply? Until 9 May 2021
- Who can apply? The application should refer to a project, which has received EU co-financing from the European Regional Development Fund, the Cohesion Fund, the European Social Fund, or a project which has received EU funding under Interreg IPA-CBC or Interreg ENI-CBC programmes, starting earliest at 1 January 2007.


Step 4: Submit your application
