I. Context

“More than eight in ten respondents (**85%**) think that the existence of fake news is a problem in their country, at least to some extent. A similar proportion (83%) say that it is a problem for democracy in general.”

“Respondents are most likely to think that journalists should act to stop the spread of fake news (45%), followed by **national authorities (39%), EU institutions (21%)** and other.”

Myths and Facts about EU Cohesion policy

Cohesion policy does not contribute to defending the EU's fundamental values ^

EU values are at the core of projects financed by EU Cohesion policy. Principles such as gender equality or non-discrimination are even more prominent in the new legislative package proposed for the post-2020 period. For example, the respect of these principles is compulsory when it comes to project selection.

EU-funded projects themselves are a means of spreading EU values on the ground all over Europe – whether these values are specifically mentioned in the projects or not.

Barely 1.8% of funding was affected by irregularities between 2013 and 2017. Only a tiny fraction of those irregularities was fraudulent, the rest being mistakes.

III. How can you help? The **INFORM – REGIO** workflow in fighting online disinfo

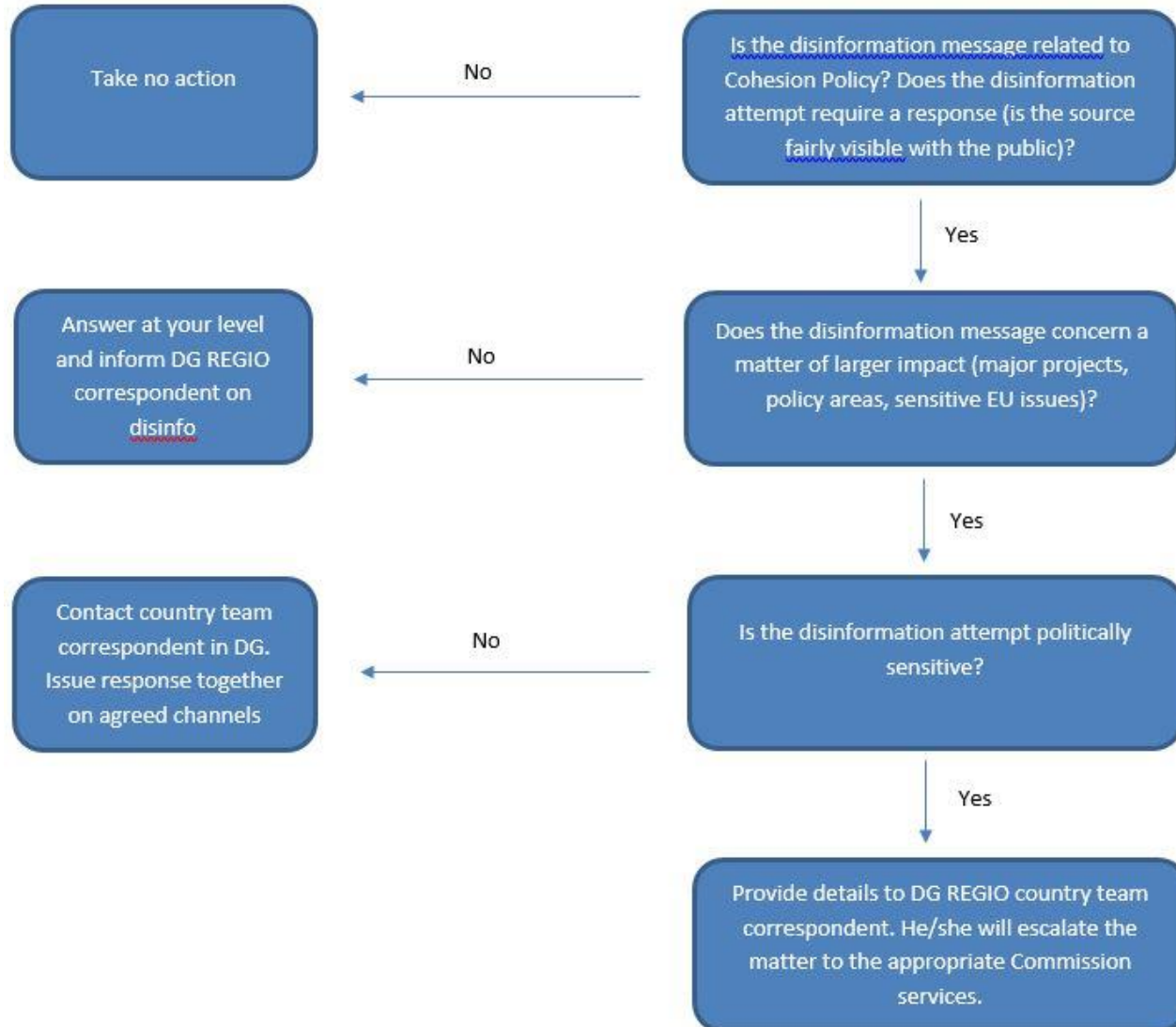
A **collaboration scheme** between the INFORM network and DG REGIO in reacting to online disinformation (myths, fake news) on cohesion policy.

- ensure a **rapid reaction** (maximum 1 hour);
- be **proportional** (the reactions must match the intensity and gravity of the disinformation);
- delegate to the **appropriate level of response**.

The aim is to react fast to online news articles and reports, social media posts and comments from public figures.
