Methodology

- The survey was conducted via telephone interviews
- Fieldwork: from 9 June to 22 June 2023
- Target population: EU citizens, 15 years and over
- Coverage: EU27
- Sampling methodology: dual frame, landline and mobile, probability design
- Number of interviews: 25 718
- Sample size per country: 500 in LU, CY, MT, 1000 in all other countries

Presentation of survey data

• Survey data are **weighted** to marginal age, gender, activity status and region population distributions using *rim* weighting. The EU27 averages are weighted according to the size of the 15+ population of each country.

Note: Percentages may not total 100 due to rounding.






Awareness of EU cohesion policy


Europe provides financial support to regions and cities. Have you heard about any EU co-financed projects to improve the area where you live?










Europe provides financial support to regions and cities. Have you heard about any EU co-financed projects to improve the area where you live? (%)







Have you heard about any **EU co-financed projects to improve the area where you live?** (% yes)




Structural funds (ERDF and CF) eligibility, 2014-2020

Are you aware that the **EU regional policy supported Member States** in the **health emergency response and economic recovery** in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic?




% 'Yes', comparison with 2021 (modified trend)






Awareness of EU funds

Awareness of ERDF/CF, ESF, Interreg, JTF







Impact of EU co-financed projects on development in local areas










EU regional policy can invest in many different domains. Which of the following examples do you consider among the more important or less important for your city or region?

Education, health or social infrastructures emerges as the top (or top equal) policy domain in 24 Member States, and the environment in 6 Member States.

In Italy, research and innovation is the top policy domain, and in Denmark, this is renewable, clean energy and energy networks (joint-highest).
