S3 CoP Working Group on Industrial Transition

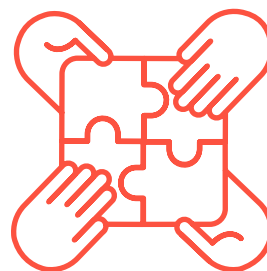
Overall objective

The main purpose of this Working Group is four-fold:

- to collect and document existing knowledge and good practices;
- to identify common needs, problems and challenges;
- to co-develop with the regions potential solutions (new approaches, policies, instruments, and coordination mechanisms);
- to support and monitor the deployment of solutions and adapt them to regional specificities.

Approach

The activities of the WG will follow a bottom-up, iterative and peer learning approach to facilitate exchanges of experience and knowledge among regional stakeholders. Special focus will be placed on the regional institutional context.



Main focus

The main **two implementation challenges** selected for this WG are: **understanding systemic change and inclusive industrial transition: leave no region behind**. Regional stakeholders will share their experience in assessing and managing practices on:

- **Transformative change:** analysing regional context and innovation potential; developing shared visions; setting up S3 processes governance; prioritising and aligning industrial transition opportunities with regional innovation systems transition agendas; defining policy mix, roadmaps, and action plans; and experimentation with the wider regional stakeholders.
- **Supporting the deployment of innovation:** addressing financial and non-financial barriers; identifying funding gaps; identifying and developing instruments to fill funding gaps.

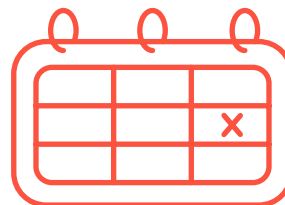
