Overall objective

The main purpose of this Working Group is four-fold:

- to collect and document existing knowledge and good practices;
- to identify common needs, problems and challenges;
- to co-develop with the regions potential solutions (new approaches, policies, instruments, and coordination mechanisms);
- to support and monitor the deployment of solutions and adapt them to regional specificities.

Approach

The activities of the WG will follow a bottom-up, iterative and peer learning approach to facilitate exchanges of experience and knowledge among regional stakeholders. Special focus will be placed on the regional institutional context.



Main focus

The **two main implementation challenges** selected for this WG are: **lack of systemic approach and weak articulation of the demand for innovation and for innovation support services.** The discussions will be framed considering the **four key issues** for the success of smart specialisation strategies:

- The adoption of new technologies, innovations, business practices and digital tools across the business population (and especially among SMEs) from leading firms to those lagging behind.
- Collaboration between universities and RTOs and the local business community.
- Knowledge spillovers and innovation diffusion channels between large firms and indigenous smaller enterprises.
- The role of innovation agencies and other public bodies in facilitating knowledge flows.


