2021-2020 reform elements

- Expanded list of common indicators captured by monitoring system (covering ERDF/CF Specific objectives)
- Introduction of result indicators ("outcomes" for beneficiaries) including common results (RCR indicators) and possible specific result indicators
- Results to be measured at / after completion (i.e. within 12 months)
- Retained from 2014-2020
 - Target setting at programming + Milestones for outputs
 - Reporting progress based on decided/selected projects + implemented projects

Transport investments are significant

 More that EUR 70 billion in EU funding in 2014-2020 – ERDF + CF

Must also be covered by common + specific result indicators



2021-2020 requirements

- Targets:
 - Established by specific objective; before project selection; estimated based on assumptions;
 - PF methodology to explain choice of RCR or other result indicator and assumptions;
- Forecasts from decided / selected projects:
 - Selected operations to provide baselines and targets (estimates) based on available data;
- Achievements (implemented):
 - Projects / Operations to provide measurement within 12 months (transport expertise)
- Value: Narrative for communication; Use in later impact evaluation
