## The main challenge for the period 2021-2027

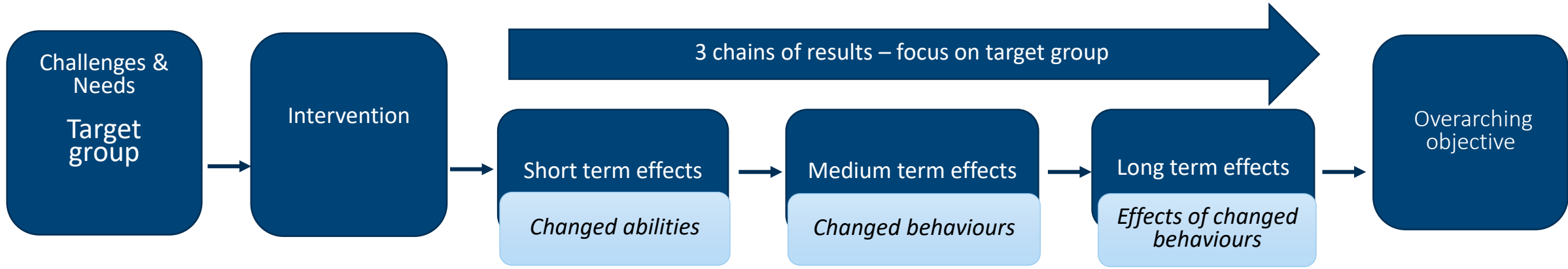
- Evaluations pointed to common root cause

- Chains of results as a tool in programming and implementation



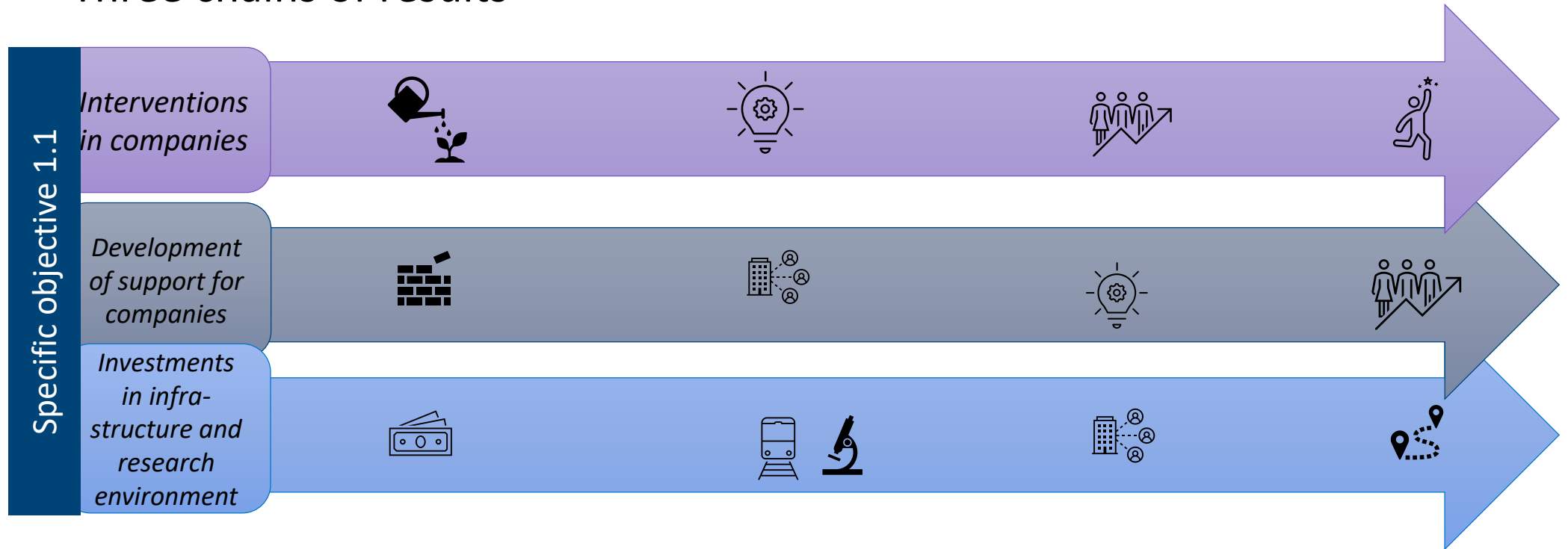
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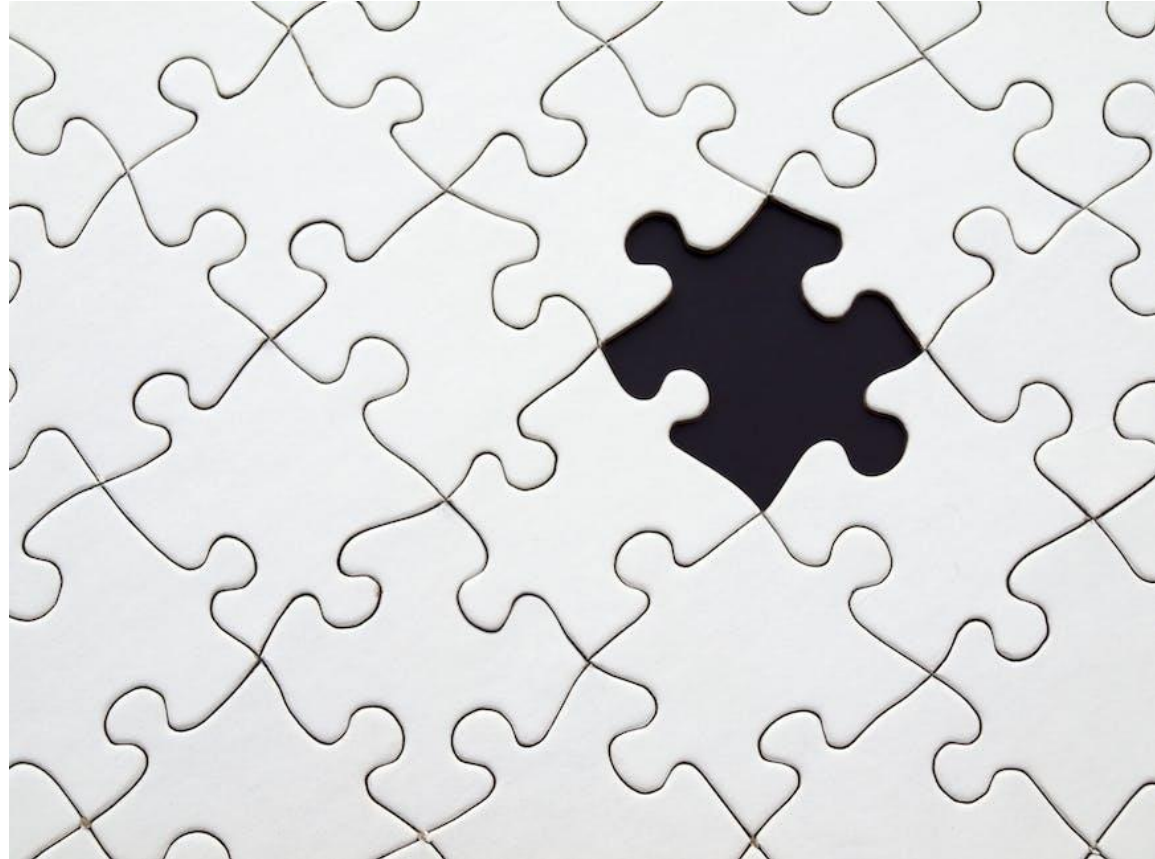


### Three chains of results

- ▀ Balance between territorial / thematic (specific objective)



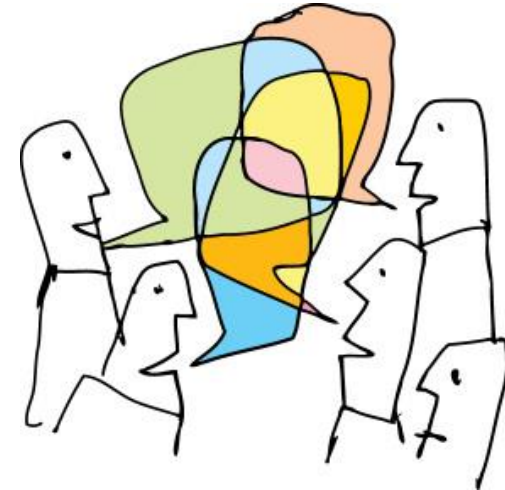
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# Timing – highlight the use of every evaluation! Use the evaluation criterias and evaluation questions to clarify

= **Formative** - support and improve the design and implementation of the programmes.  
Relevance, coherence, efficiency



= **Summative** – assess impact. Effectiveness, efficiency.

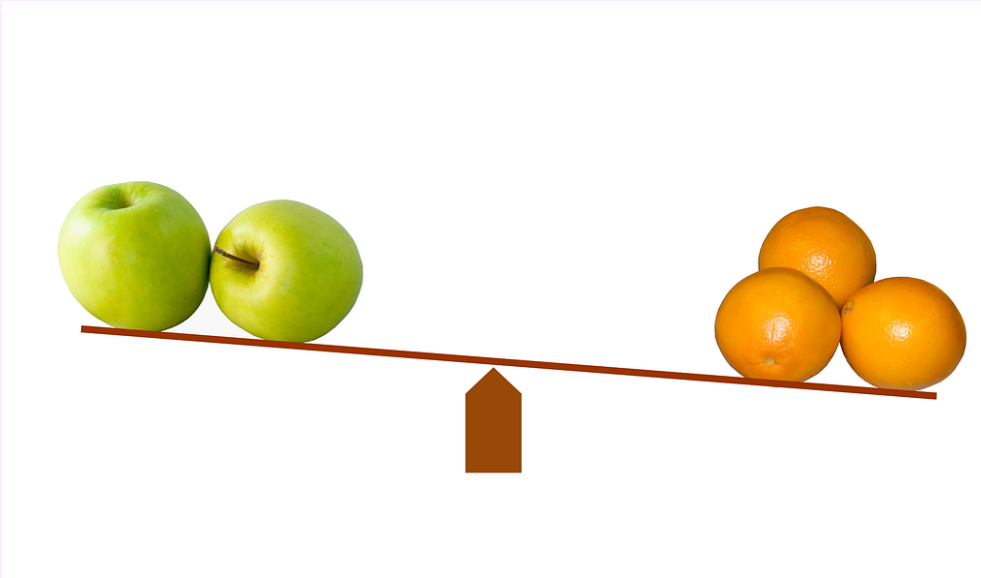


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# Balance territorial perspectives with a thematic approach
