2021-2027 SWD on Performance, Monitoring and Evaluation

Consultation process with MS Sept. 18 – June 2019 through the EvalNetwork and final MS comments provided **Dec. 2019**

Indicator fiches were added to Staff Working Document Annex I and submitted for internal consultation to all DGs in **Mar. 2021** Adoption of the CPR, and ERDF/CF Regulation **expected this summer**

MS comments have been addressed and processed into a revised list of indicators fiches with additional 3 indicators added by the EP in **February 2021** + 2 JTF indicators added

Q&A in CIRCABC for targeted questions on post-2020 indicators

Comments from all DGs are being taken into consideration and **finalised fiches** produced for final adoption.



Changes to SWD text since 12/2020

- No change to the basic structure
- Clarifications of drafting / presentation / referencing, including
 - Synthesis added of the key changes linked to performance + monitoring
 - Clarification on the meaning of asterisked indicators,
 - Clarification on time of collection of values for results
- References to the wider Interreg family of cooperation programmes



Evaluation and evaluation planning

- As discussed, the evaluation text was developed based on experience from the 2014-2020 period; thanks to minor legislative changes (mainly simplification) there is a strong continuity in the approach;
- The document is practical and leaves methodological questions for further discussions; Evaluet is one place for these discussion (Helpdesk feedback, methodological papers, etc.,)
- First challenge is the evaluation plan: Helpdesk support is available to assist in evaluation planning for the 2021-2027 period.
- However, we still need to complete the evaluation of the 2014-2020 implementaton.



INDICATORS + MONITORING

- Pre-draft of Indicator description (fiche) were provided in CIRCABC on 31 May including
 - Anticipation of final legislation and new indicators
 - Track changes to last draft included internal EC coordination
- Work continued to finalise and eliminate inconsistencies post Inter Service Cconsulation +



Legislative changes linked to indicators (1/2)

- New Specific Objectives + transfer of specific objectives
- Indicators with added asterisks (allowing use across SO s + PO s)
- Changes in indicator reporting template for results with baselines
- New indicators from Trilogues + JTF



Indicator Fiche: Changes being taken on board

Objective: Minimise changes to the fiche already circulated as far as possible

- 1. New Fiches for 7 ERDF and 2 JTF indicators
- 2. Correction of specific objectives / uses across SOs
- 3. Changes to descriptions arising from MS / programme clarification questions
- 4. Rare changes to measurement units / definitions
- 5. Harmonisation of terms used across indicator descriptions
- 6. Technical correction of references and typographical / syntax corrections



Changes not taken on board

- Comments that were not in accordance with the indicator names listed in draft legislation or issues agreed in Council compromise (i.e. request to eliminate the concept of enterprise subsets to be reported)
- Comments linked to specific national circumstances or specific (rare) project circumstances (to be addressed bilaterally)
- MS comments that were address at
 - The seminar on transport result with JASPERS
 - The seminar on estimating GHG emissions with EIB

CATEGORISATION

- Major revision of intervention fields
 - to align RRP and Cohesion systems; touches particularly clarifications on the use of higher climate weightings;
 - Renumbering of codes compared to Trilogues (mapping of RRF codes will be available)
- Merged: Territorial delivery mechanism and territorial focus dimension
- New Dimensions
 - Gender equality dimension
 - Macro-Regional and sea basin strategies
