- ☐ General rules many indicators:
 - Data collection: supported projects, surveys, public registries
 - Time measurement achieved:
 - upon completion of output in supported projects (outputs)
 - one year after the completion of output (results)
 - Aggregation: removal of double counting at the level of specific objective (when applicable)
 - Reporting: disaggregated values only in implementation

- More specific rules for some indicators:
 - Time measurement

RCO03 "Enterprises supported by financial instruments" - differentiated by loans and guarantees, and for venture capital

RCO18 "Dwellings with improved energy performance" – upon completion of output and issuance of the energy performance certificate



- ☐ More specific rules for some indicators:
 - Use of indicator (in Notes)

RCO05 – New enterprises supported – use together with RCO01 and indicators for the forms of support (grants, financial instruments)

RCO16 Participations of institutional stakeholders in entrepreneurial discovery process – indicator is to be used for participations in consultations financed by technical assistance of the OP.

- ☐ More specific rules for some indicators:
 - Demarcation (in Notes)

RCO36 "Green infrastructure supported for other purposes than adaptation to climate change" – indicator to be used when the objective with the green infrastructure supported is other than adaptation to climate change (recorded in RCO26)



- ☐ Changes in "Definition and concepts"
 - Clarification of terms
 - Alignment of terms between indicator name and definition (ex: upgraded, modernised etc)
 - (Non-exhaustive) examples provided, where feasible
 - References for definition of concepts (ex: renewable energy)
 - Avoided overspecification
