REACT-EU

- REACT-EU will be programmed in 2021+2022 as part of 2014-2020 programmes
- First adopted amounts are already visible under “finances planned”

Upcoming (early May 2021)

- A new REACT-EU thematic page will make this additional financing and planned achievements transparent (publication early May)
- A new story will provide further data and narrative and act as an adoption dashboard

Updated platform - Design

- homepage will present the two periods separately
- for previous funding period, the elements would be maintained.
- no overview page aggregating the achievements and financial data of all funds.
- cohesion policy will have a page where ERDF, ESF+, CF and JTF achievements and financial data will be aggregated.
- more details on specific objectives, programmes, EU payments and implementation data will be included in later (2022) phases.

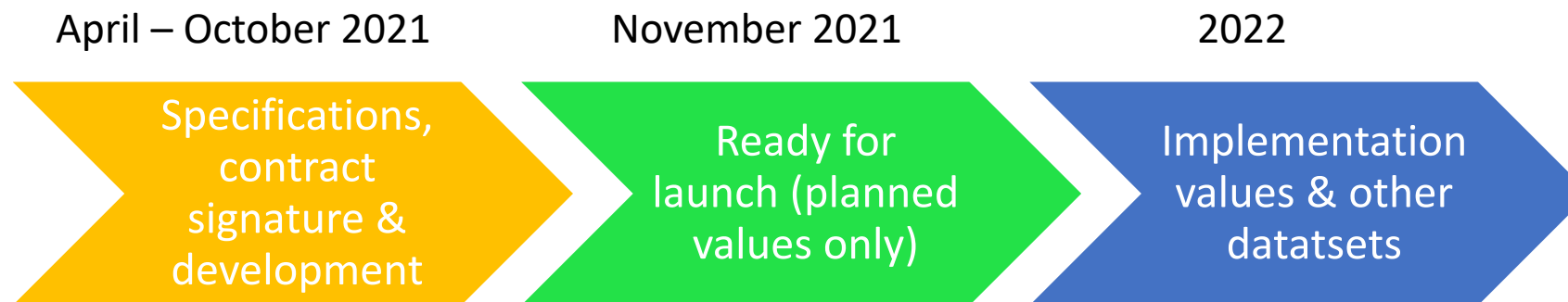

Updated platform - Rebranding

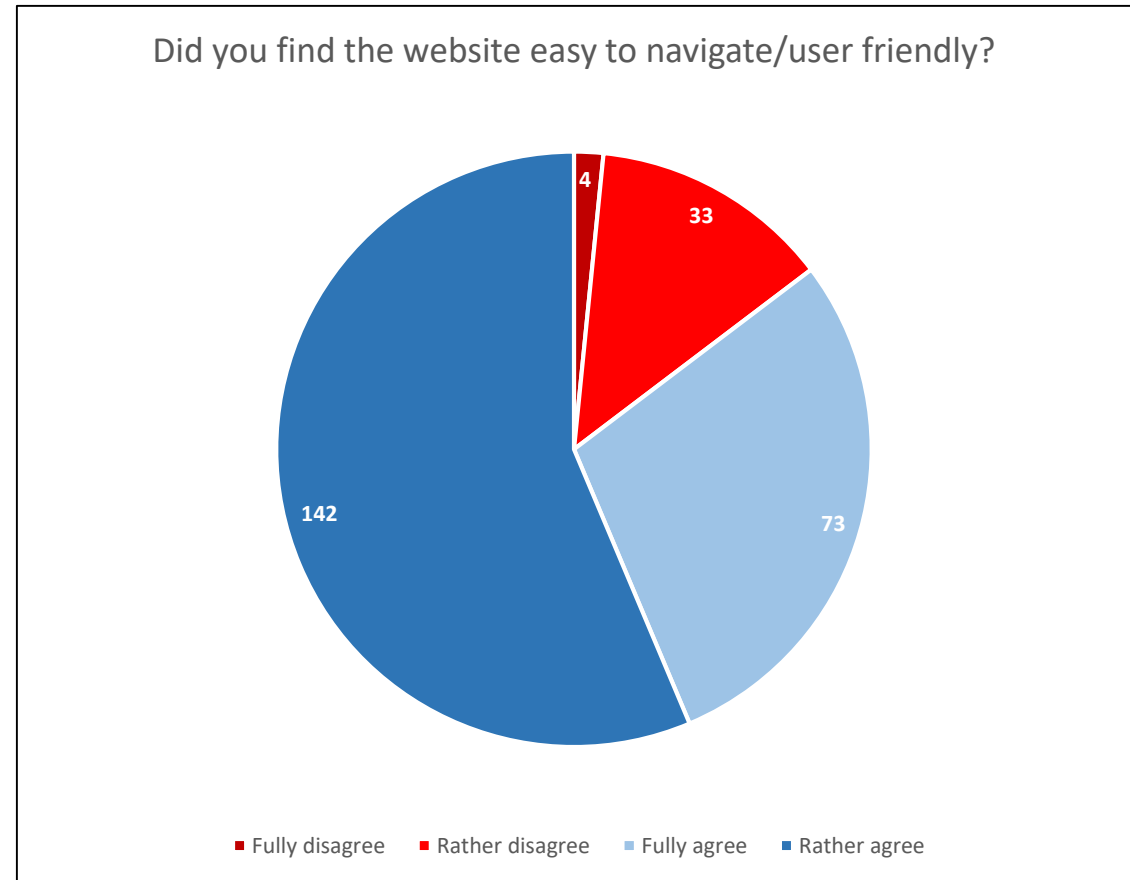
- Now: #ESIFOpenData <https://cohesiondata.ec.europa.eu/>

Timing of the works

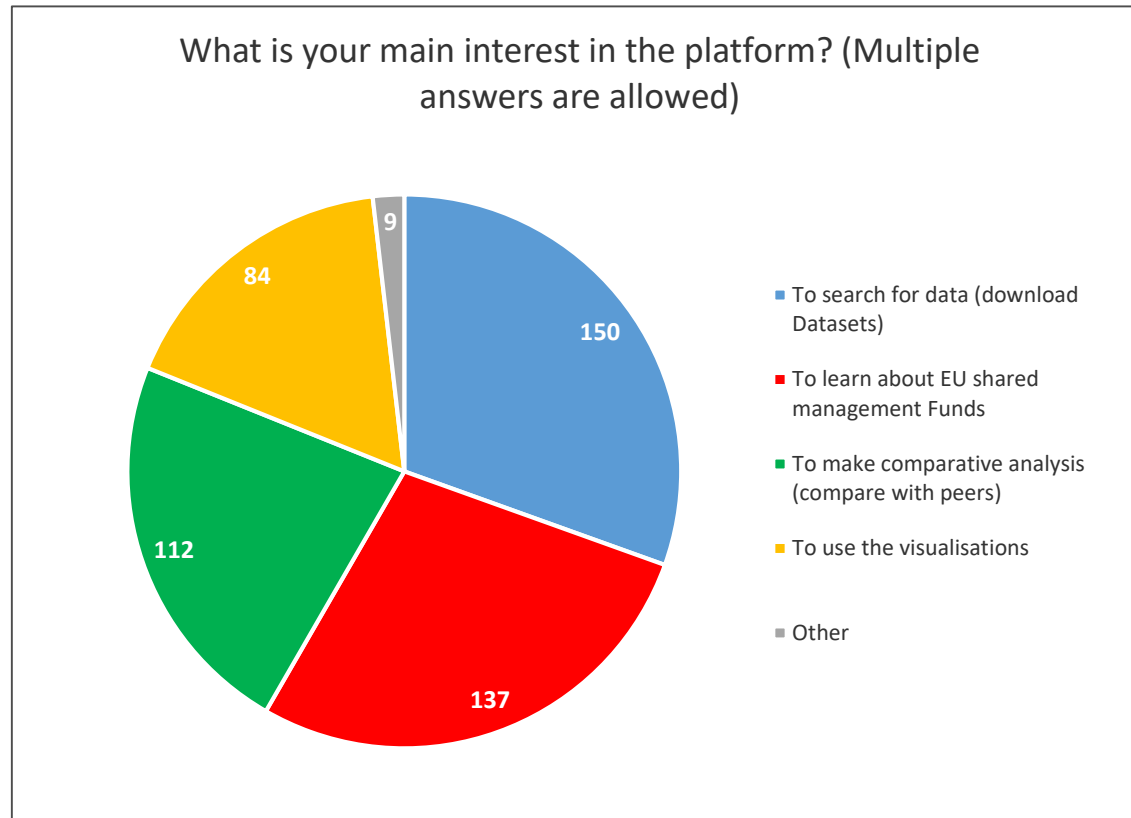


2021 survey: user satisfaction

- Carried out every 2 years
- User satisfaction & collect ideas for improvements
- 261 replies
- Key stakeholders were invited to participate: EGESIF, EVALNET, Social Partners, etc.



2021 user survey: main interest & suggestions



Main ideas suggested by the respondents for future improvements :

- Include project level data and improve of the interactive map to display projects
- Add the possibility to filter data by NUTS 2 and NUTS 3 regions
- Display common items to link the 2014-20 and the 2021-27 periods
- Translate the main pages into other EU languages (currently only in English)
- Organize trainings on the possibilities offered by the platform
- Include links to other databases (SEDIA, keep.eu, Interreg.eu)
- Include data on programme-specific indicators
