Background

Administrative capacity in public administrations is a prerequisite for effective and efficient implementation of public policies

Cohesion policy requires:

- skilled public servants,
- efficient organisations,
- within a multi-level governance context



Administrative capacity should be addressed at the very beginning or even before the actual start of a new programming period.

What is the pilot action about?

- Close cooperation with five Managing Authorities (MA) to develop and implement Roadmaps for administrative capacity building
- The MAs will benefit from technical support to analyse and address their administrative capacity building needs
- DG REGIO will cooperate with and use the expertise of the OECD for implementing the pilot
- Experiences will be disseminated and used for developing a method to strengthen the administrative capacity of all interested MAs


