


Support to civil society is a key priority for loeland, Liechtenstein and Norway in the EEA and Norway Grants. An Active Citizens Fund funded by the three donors will be established in each of the 16 beneficiary countries of the Grants. The objective is to develop the long-term sustainability and capacity of civil society organisations (CSOs) and the civil society sector as a whole, with the aim of strengthening its role in contributing to policy and systemic change, promoting democratic participation and active citizenship.






