JTP Working Groups

The new JTP Working Groups being launched in 2024 will include two Working Groups on the topics of **stakeholder engagement** and **equal opportunities**. The new Working Groups focus on all JTF regions (coal and carbon-intensive) to leave no one behind. They will focus on proper implementation of the Just Transition Fund (JTF) and bring together a varied group of stakeholders to closely monitor the just transition process, share competencies, and formulate guidelines for the implementation of JTF projects linked to their area of competences.

The **Working Group on stakeholder engagement** will cut across the different transition sectors (energy, steel, cement, chemicals, etc.) as well as the different directly affected segments of society from JTF territories. The mission of this Working Group will be to identify and assess approaches and good practices for engaging different stakeholder groups at the level of implementation of the JTM.

The **Working Group on equal opportunities** will act as an observatory focusing specifically on the most vulnerable and underrepresented groups of the just transition: youth, elderly, rural communities, women and other groups. The mission of this Working Group is to bring advocacy organisations, JTF Managing Authorities and other decision-makers to the same table to discuss and find ways to ensure that the implementation of the JTM benefits these groups of stakeholders and creates equal opportunities. A **dedicated JTP Youth Force** within this Working Group will focus on skills and challenges of the youth.

The Working Groups will be established for a period of approximatively three years (until the end of the year 2026) and will meet regularly, both in person and online.

How to apply

The JTP Working Groups are open to a mix of relevant stakeholders involved in the just transition processes, coming from public entities, social partners, NGOs and umbrella organisations, that can represent and bring a diverse range of views, experiences, and knowledge to the Working Groups.
