JTPeers Exchange – Call for regional practitioners to join exchanges of the Just Transition Platform (JTP)

The European Commission invites relevant Just Transition Fund (JTF) regional practitioners from public authorities, civil society, and socio-economic actors active in JTF territories to participate in the JTP's peer-exchange programme: JTPeers Exchange. This call is open for experienced institutions and organisations working towards Territorial Just Transition Plan (TJTP) implementation in relevant territories, whose expertise helps to implement just transition in carbon-intensive territories across the EU.

Interested regions can apply individually or jointly with up to three JTF regions. If applying individually, applicants will be matched with a suitable counterpart from the pool of applicants. A joint application is intended to leverage existing cooperation between JTF regions and suitable in cases where regions already have preferences on who they would like to exchange with on a given topic.

The only valid way to apply is via this EU Survey questionnaire for individual applications for JTPeers Exchange by the deadline of submission: 1 March 2024 at 23:00 CET. If you prefer applying jointly with other regions, please use this form for joint applications.

The JTPeers Exchange programme consists of facilitated knowledge-sharing between one eligible JTF territory and counterparts from one or two other eligible territories or a just transition expert.

While validating these applications for JTPeers Exchange, the European Commission will focus primarily on urgent needs and relevant professional experience, while also ensuring meaningful gender balance among participants.

 - Expert-to-region exchange. Expert-region exchanges take place between one just transition expert and up to three JTF regions. They are intended for regions seeking advice on one specific topic or question.
