2. Application procedure

The objective of this call for expressions of interest is to set up a list of external senior and junior experts to support the implementation of the European Structural and Investment Funds in the fields and themes as set out in the standard application form (ref. document 3.a Standard Application form).

Expressions of interest should be submitted by e-mail to the following address: REGIO-CEI-AMI-EXPERTS@ec.europa.eu. The expression of interest must include all documents mentioned in the first section of point 3, including the standard application form (see Annex 1), which can be downloaded from the link below. Only this standard application form, not reformatted in any way, is valid.

Inclusion on the list entails no obligation on the part of the contracting authority concerning the conclusion of contracts.

3. Information and documents to be provided

Interested parties should provide their full contact details and indicate the specific themes under the fields listed in annex 1.

The following files or documents should be submitted now:

- a) **Standard Application Form** with the themes and qualifications marked (the template of the standard application form can be found in the annexes provided in the publication). Experts can apply for themes in **three fields** only. The Application form should sent in Excel.
- b) **Document(s) providing evidence of the ability to draft and communicate** in English and at least one other official EU language (to be annexed to the application form as annex 1, in pdf format. If several documents, they can be numerated as 1a, 1b, 1c etc.). The documents could either be a formal certificate, e.g. a DELF certificate, or (a) reference(s) to accessible documents having been drafted by the interested party.
- c) Document(s) providing evidence of the professional experience in the field(s) selected (to be annexed to the application form as annex 2, in pdf format. If several documents, they can be numerated as 2a, 2b, 2c etc.). (The supporting evidence to be provided for the evaluation of the selection criteria are indicated at point 11.).
- d) **List of projects, studies & publications** for at least four years of experience for senior experts and at least two years of experience for junior experts, relevant to the field(s) chosen (to be annexed to the application form as annex 3, in pdf format).
- e) Curriculum vitae Europass or other form (to be annexed to the application form as annex 4, in pdf format).
 - f) **Declaration of honour** on exclusion criteria and selection criteria signed and dated (template is annexed to this call as annex 2; to be annexed to the application form as annex 5 in pdf format). See also point 10 on exclusion criteria.

Experts, with whom the Commission concludes a contract under this call for the first time, will be requested to submit the following documents:

- a) **Legal Entity Form** duly completed, stamped and signed (template can be downloaded here: http://ec.europa.eu/budget/contracts grants/info contracts/legal entities/legal entities en.cfm#en)
- b) For natural persons, copy of the identity card / passport

For legal persons, **copy of the VAT registration document**; if the VAT number does not appear on this official document, a copy of any other official document (official gazette, company register etc.) showing the name of the legal person, the address of the head office and the registration number provided by the national authorities. In addition, **documentary evidence** is required **for the unavailability of the expert to be assigned tasks** *as natural person* (for example, the employment contract of the expert or any other document mentioning an exclusivity clause whereby expertise services for other parties can only be contracted through the legal person).

c) Financial identification form duly completed, stamped and signed (template to be downloaded here:

The Commission reserves the right to request additional or updated documents and to review its assessment of the Application file on the basis of the original documents submitted.

4. General description of the procedure

As a general rule, this call is open to natural and legal persons. Legal persons must apply with an identified expert ad personam.

The contracting authority will establish a pool of experts who meet the criteria set out at point 11 and who are having the qualifications and/or experience as described in annex 1 to this call.

Where a particular task relating to the themes described in annex 1 is to be performed by an external expert, the contracting authority will assign experts to the task on the basis of the skills, experience and knowledge necessary and in accordance with the principles of non-discrimination, equal treatment and absence of conflict of interests.

Tasks assigned to legal persons shall be performed by the expert identified ad personam in the application following this call.

Whilst maintaining the principle of choosing the most qualified expert for a specific task requested, the contracting authority will also take into account, where possible, an appropriate rotation of experts.

Individual assignments shall not exceed 50 working days unless in exceptional and duly justified cases.

5. Protection of personal data

If processing your expression of interest involves the recording and processing of personal data (such as your name, address and CV), such data will be processed pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 2018/1725 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Community institutions and bodies and on the free movement of such data. Unless indicated otherwise, your reply to this notice and any personal data requested are required for the purposes indicated above in point 4 and will be processed solely for those purposes by the contracting authority indicated in point 1, which is also acting as data controller. 6. Use of the list resulting from this notice

The pool resulting from this notice will be used exclusively for tasks to be carried out as described in point 7 and within the fields and themes as described in annex 1 to the application form referred to in point 3(a) of this call.

The maximum amount for total payments of remunerations per expert throughout the duration of the call for the execution of the tasks within the fields covered by this call, shall be below the threshold laid down in point (b) of Article 4 of Directive 2014/24/EU. This threshold shall apply to natural and legal persons.

7. General tasks to be performed by experts, if applicable and not specified in annex 1

- Drafting of terms of reference for call for proposals and tender invitations;
- Evaluation of proposals for the award of grants;
- Evaluation of tenders for procurement;
- Evaluation of projects submitted for RegioStars awards;
- Involvement in and contributions to conferences, workshops, seminars or meetings;
- Drafting of discussion papers and guidance documents in the fields listed in annex 1;
- Technical assistance for the follow-up and final evaluation of pilot projects and preparatory actions;
- Technical advice and strategic guidance (to Commission services but also to Member States (national/regional/local authorities) on Commission request) with regard to any of the following areas:
 - O Design of implementation measures (including simplification) and set up of indicators;
 - O Dissemination of information by preparing specific meetings, workshops and conferences and/or documentation related to these events;
 - Closure of programmes funded by the Structural Funds;

8. Place of delivery

Tasks shall be carried out at the expert's premises, using electronic communication tools. Exceptionally, tasks may be required to be carried out at the European Commission's premises. They may also need to be performed on other locations that will be mentioned in the contract's specifications.

9. Duration of the list resulting from this call for expressions of interest

The list resulting from this notice is valid for five years as of 5 April 2022. Interested parties may submit an application at any time prior to the last three months of validity of the list.

10. Exclusion criteria

The applicants shall provide a declaration on their honour stating that they are not in one of the situations referred to in Articles 136(1) and 141 of the Financial regulation². In case of doubt, they may be requested to provide supporting evidence of non-exclusion.

At the time of the call this threshold is set at EUR 140 000

Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union, repealing Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012 (2012 Financial Regulation) (OJ L 193, 30.07.2018, p. 1)

In case of an assignment, the expert will be requested to confirm the absence of conflict of interest (Annex 3 to the contract).

11. Selection criteria relating to technical and professional capacity

- 1. Criterion: Relevant, professional experience in the field(s) selected
 - Thresholds:
 - <u>Senior experts</u>: Seven years or more. Applicants may include a Ph.D. degree in their statement on experience, in which case the threshold is eight years including both the time spent on the Ph.D. degree and minimum six years of relevant, professional experience after the Ph.D degree.³ In case of several Ph.D. degrees, the requirement of relevant, professional experience is calculated as of the awarding of the first Ph.D. degree.
 - Junior experts: Three years or more.
 - Supporting evidence: Copy of contracts, any other documents confirming the length and the level of the professional experience; annex 3 to the application file (list of projects, studies and publications) will provide clear indication of the subject/thematic work and of the start/end dates
- 2. Criterion: Ability to draft and communicate in English at C1 level and minimum at B2 level for at least one other EU official language
 - *Threshold*: C1 level for English and at least B2 level for a further working language or other EU official language indicated in the application form⁴
 - Supporting evidence: copy of certificates, studies, reports, publications...

12. Conditions of remuneration and reimbursement of experts

Senior experts shall be remunerated at a fixed price of EUR 700/day worked. Junior experts shall be remunerated at a fixed price of EUR 450/day worked. The travel and subsistence expenses will be reimbursed under the conditions set out in the contract.

Regardless of the remuneration levels mentioned in the first paragraph, evaluations of grant proposals, tenders and projects are remunerated at a fixed price of EUR 450/day worked. In exceptional and duly justified cases, the remuneration may be fixed at a level of EUR 700/day worked.

13. Ex-post transparency

A list of experts who have concluded a contract of more than EUR 15 000, shall be published on the website of the contracting authority no later than 30 June of the year following contract. The information on the list will contain the name of the expert, the locality (region of origin), amount, and subject of the contract. The information shall be removed two years after the year of contract award.
