**Q1.** Our question is about « 6.1 Eligible applicants », about this sentence: "Proposals may be submitted by universities and other educational institutions teaching journalism at undergraduate and graduate level that are located in an EU Member State and accredited under the legislation of that country ».

We would like to know whether the universities or other educational institutions are required to provide a specific course in journalism (eg. Bachelors of Journalism) or if "eligible institutions" also includes those institutions that cover journalism studies as part of a broader program (eg. Bachelor of political sciences - Major in journalism)?

**A1.** The requirement under section 6.1 includes journalism studies that are part of a broader programme.
