"Pour les points de contact des bassins (au moins 4), une déclaration sur l'honneur par point de contact attestant qu'ils ont déjà résidé et résideront dans une région ultrapériphérique pendant toute la durée de la mise en œuvre du projet. Les déclarations sur l'honneur doivent être signées par les points de contact des bassins concernés. "

Comment comprendre : Points de contacts des bassins?

Translation

[At the end of the standard grant application form for "grants for an action"], it is written:

"For the (at least 4) basin contact points, a declaration on honour per basin contact point declaring they have already resided and will be residing in an outermost region during the whole project implementation. The declarations on honour must be signed by the respective basin contact point."

How should "basin contact points" be understood?

A1. Please refer to Section 8.2 – Operational Capacity – of the call for proposals. In particular we draw your attention to the below information which can be found in this section:

"Applicants must have the professional competencies as well as appropriate qualifications necessary to complete the proposed action. The organisations/entities that apply to this call have to identify at least:

- one contact point from the Caribbean-Amaçonia basin;
- one contact point from the south-west Indian Ocean sea basin;
- and two contact points from the Macaronesia sea basin (one from Azores/Madeira and one from the Canary Islands)."
