Call for experts to assist the European Commission and other EU bodies with tasks in connection with pilot projects and preparatory actions

- 1. The European Commission is launching a **call for experts** for the Funding & Tenders Portal expert database, for assignments in connection with EU **pilot projects and preparatory actions** (**PPs & PAs**) for grants:
 - (a) evaluation of proposals in response to calls for proposals
 - (b) monitoring of the implementation of actions carried out under the PPs & PAs

Pilot projects and preparatory actions are initiatives to test new funding schemes. Pilot projects are of experimental nature and designed to test the feasibility of a funding scheme and its usefulness (duration of normally around two years). Preparatory actions are normally the follow-up to a successful pilot project and designed to test and prepare the scheme in view of turning it into a standing EU funding programme (duration of normally around three years).

Pilot projects and preparatory actions may be managed by various services (Commission or other EU bodies) and may cover any EU policy area. They are formally self-standing and not part of existing EU funding programmes.

 The Commission and other EU bodies managing pilot projects and preparatory actions are looking for experts with a high level of expertise and professional experience in all fields of EU policy.

Appropriate language skills (in particular in English) are mandatory.

The **selection** will be done from the database, on the basis of professional capacity and selection criteria that ensure good quality expertise, language skills, geographical and business-sector balance, gender balance, regular rotation, absence of conflict of interest. The procedure will be objective and fully compliant with the principles of non-discrimination and equal treatment.

If needed and duly justified, experts may exceptionally also be selected from outside the database.

The Commission and other EU bodies may call upon the advice of advisory bodies for the selection of experts.

5. **!mportant**:

All sections of the online application form must be completed (and kept up-to-date). Areas of expertise and professional experience must be adequately detailed and documented. The registration will be considered complete only once marked as valid.

The remuneration for EU experts assignments are published on the <u>EU Funding & Tenders</u> Portal.

Registration via the online application form does not automatically mean that you will be selected for task assignments.

If selected for assignments involving classified information, you will need to get appropriate security clearance before starting on the assignment and be validated by the national security authority (NSA) of your Member State.

Selected experts will be managed via the <u>EU Funding & Tenders Portal</u>. By submitting this application, you agree to accept to use the electronic exchange system in accordance with the Funding & Tenders Portal Terms & Conditions.
