The Research Executive Agency, assisted by independent experts, has completed the evaluation of the proposals submitted to the above call. The breakdown of evaluation results per topic (also referred to as 'implementation mode') is as follows:

MSCA-IF-2014- GF (Global Fellowships)

Total budget requested from these above-threshold proposals:	207,757,282.00 €

It is expected that the first grant agreements will be signed by March 2015.
