The Commission and the Agency have now completed the evaluation of the proposals submitted to the above-mentioned call.

The results of the evaluation are as follows:

Number of proposals submitted: 167

Number of inadmissible proposals: 2

Number of ineligible proposals: 1

Number of above-threshold proposals: 97

Total budget requested for above-threshold proposals: EUR 312, 877, 955. 43

We recently informed the applicants about the evaluation results for their proposals.

It is expected that the first grant agreements will be signed by 2 October 2017.

Additional Information on weighting and scoring for Innovation Actions

(Topics: CO-CREATION-01-2017 and CO-CREATION-04-2017):

- According to the H2020 WORK PROGRAMME 2016–2017 and its General Annexes for Innovation actions to determine the ranking, the score for the criterion ‘Impact’ has been given a weight of 1.5. Taking this into account, the calculation of the normalised scores is done as follows:


Normalized Score = [(Score under criterion 'EXCELLENCE' + Score under criterion 'IMPACT' * 1.5 + Score under criterion 'IMPLEMENTATION')/17.5]*15.

Example: For a proposal that has scored 3.5, 4 and 2.5 under Excellence, Impact and Implementation respectively, the normalized score would be calculated as follows:

Normalized score = [(3.5 + 4 * 1.5 + 2.5)/17.5]*15 = 10.28

- Priority order for proposals with the same score: in the case of Innovation Actions, the prioritisation will be done first on the basis of the score for IMPACT, and then on the score for EXCELLENCE.

Please note that the number of proposals that can finally be funded will depend on the finally available budget and the formal selection by the Commission and/or Agency.
