## Opinion on the vocational training of ground engineers and maintenance staff

(15 September 1993)

After confirming that the working party had no intention of restarting the discussions held within the JAA, both sides agreed to recommend that the Joint Committee approve JAR 65 as it stood.

They stressed the importance of maintaining a high common level of training and ensuring it was monitored effectively. Similarly, they emphasized the need to ensure free movement and avoid all discriminatory measures between Member States. The trade union representatives expressed reservations in two areas, namely the nature of the authorities responsible for issuing licences and monitoring applications, and the nature of the licence itself (single licence).

The working party proposed that the joint opinion of the two sides be recorded in the minutes of the meeting.
