


By 2020 there will be 756.000 unfilled vacancies for ICT professionals in the whole economy. However, 39% of companies report that they have difficulties finding suitably skilled ICT professionals.

How will the New Skills Agenda for Europe improve digital skills?

- **Skills Guarantee:** allows low skilled adults to acquire a minimum level of literacy, numeracy and digital skills.
- **Revision of the Key Competences Framework:** introduces core competences, including digital skills, in education and training curricula.
- **Digital Skills and Jobs Coalition:** brings Member States together to define and implement digital skills strategies, calls on them to put together national digital skills coalitions among education, employment and industry stakeholders, attracts pledges from stakeholders from ICT and ICT-using sectors to provide training to individuals.
