Launch event of the European Platform tackling undeclared work Brussels, 27 May 2016 Operational conclusions

Brussels, 30 May 2016

Member State Fact Sheets on undeclared work

The study will be sent to Platform members and observers for additional comments. Deadline for the submission of comments is Monday, 27 June 2016. Comments should be submitted to the Secretariat fully formulated in track changes mode, respecting the current structure of the fact sheets.

Rules of procedure

Platform members and observers are invited to send their comments to the Secretariat no later than Monday, 20 June 2016, fully formulated in track changes mode. The Secretariat will then circulate a master document with a consolidated overview of all received comments, clearly indicating by whom they were made.

Platform members and observers willing to become part of the working group that will elaborate a draft version of the rules of procedures are invited to express their interest no later than Monday, 20 June 2016.

The rules of procedure could be adopted by written procedure.

Call for Co-chair candidates

Candidates from among the nominated senior representatives for the position of the Co-chairs are invited to present their candidature by Monday, 6 June 2016 in an email to the Secretariat. The Secretariat will then circulate the list of the candidatures received.

The election of the Co-chairs shall take place at the next Platform meeting, scheduled to take place early October 2016.

Two-year work programme

There was general consensus on the priority fields as identified in the survey, as well as on the need to progress on them in parallel (exchange of information and good practices and improvement of knowledge and evidence; practical cooperation and joint activities including development of mechanism and tools; driving modernisation agendas and informing policy and legal developments). Additional suggestions for the work programme can be sent to the Secretariat no later than Monday 20 June 2016.

Platform members and observers willing to become part of the working group that will elaborate a draft version of the two-year work programme are invited to express their interest no later than Monday 20 June 2016, in view of an adoption of the work programme at the next plenary session in autumn.

Start-up activities

In order to keep the momentum and to avoid a gap in the start of the activities of the Platform, the Commission will initiate some concrete activities linked to the mandate of the Platform. This could include: A study on bogus self-employment, a seminar on developing a holistic approach tackling undeclared work, a mutual assistance project to Romania and a national seminar.

Next meeting

The next meeting of the Platform plenary is planned for early October 2016 in Brussels. The exact date and place will be confirmed as soon as possible.
