Austria	<p>Did you know that the Austrian Training Guarantee was even one of the models for the EU Youth Guarantee? If you are looking for a job or apprenticeship in Austria, you can turn to your local job centre (AMS) for placement and advice. If you are under 18, you are guaranteed an apprenticeship position. Under 25 year-olds receive an offer of an apprenticeship, employment, education or training. In case you face unemployment register yourself to the employment office via e-service at https://www.te-palvelut.fi/tyonhakijalle/nuoret/nuorisotakuu.</p> <p>If you have questions regarding career, education, income or for example housing turn to your local Ohjaamo one-stop-guidance center (www.ohjaamo.fi). The Youth Guarantee is about taking 3 steps towards employment or education: get in touch, meet an expert, make a plan together with the help of public employment services.
