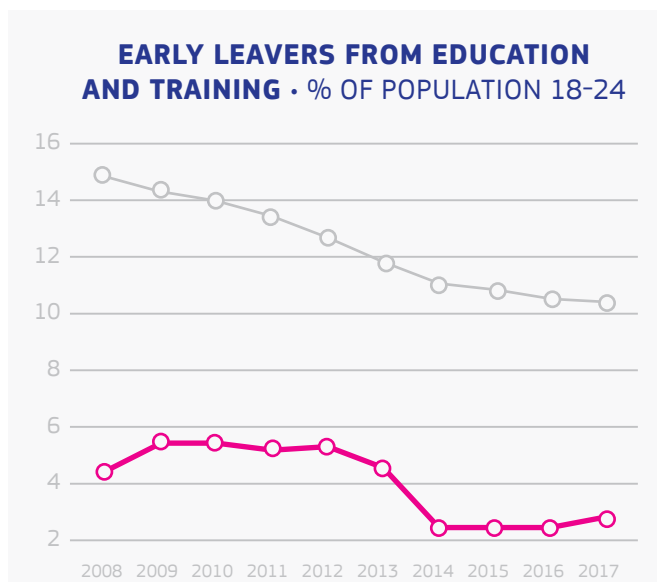

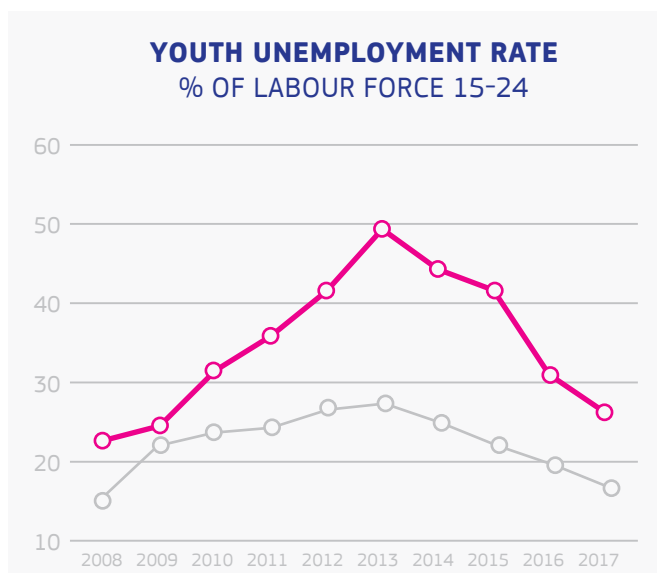
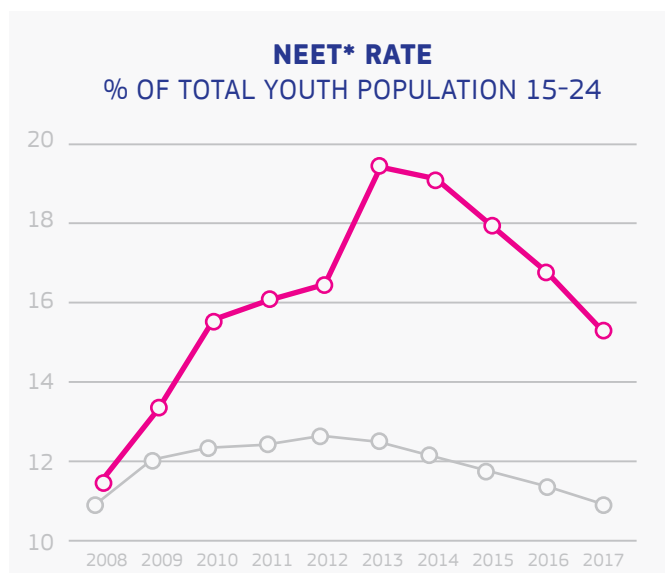

* NEET = Not in Employment, Education or Training



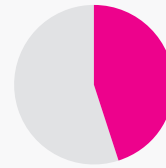

EXAMPLE OF A MEASURE SUPPORTED BY **THE YOUTH EMPLOYMENT INITIATIVE**

Active Employment Policy Measures for Young People

From November 2015 until December 2022, the project 'Implementation of active employment policy measures for young people' (Phase I and II), in the context of the YEI, have been implemented. Both phases of the project are being implemented by the Croatian Employment Service (CES) and their total value is around EUR 214,9 million. The projects target 37.441 young people. Measures such as public works, support of education, support for employment of young people, and ensuring a relevant professional experience are parts of this project.

Based on a recommendation of the YEI evaluation report 2015, the project "Establishment of NEET tracking system" was implemented in 2017 and 2018.
