




### YOUNG PEOPLE'S LABOUR MARKET PERFORMANCE (2008 > 2017)






% OF POPULATION 15-24

O National average O European average



# YEI COVERAGE

## EXAMPLE OF A MEASURE SUPPORTED BY THE YOUTH EMPLOYMENT INITIATIVE

### Voucher scheme for a first work experience

A major YEI action is the 'Voucher scheme for a first work experience for labour market entry of young people aged up to 29' (https://voucher.gov.gr), whose aim is to provide a structured pathway to the labour market by helping young people gain initial work experience in the private sector. The scheme is aimed at different age groups: (i) 12,000 NEETs (3,000 tertiary education graduates and 9,000 secondary and post-secondary education graduates) aged 15-24 (budget: EUR 43 million); and (ii) 30,000 NEETs (12,000 tertiary education graduates and 18,000 secondary and post-secondary education graduate
