Project aim

The Labor and Welfare Directorate will initiate a national attempt to try out a model for overall follow-up of low-income families based in Norwegian labour and welfare offices (NAV). The trial is included as one of the measures in the Government Strategy "Children Living in Poverty" (2015-2017).

Preventing children from lowincome families to stay poor due to lack of education, work opportunities and lack of social integration

Target group:

families who are long-term recipients of social benefits –
43% single mothers

Unique research project:

 a cluster-randomized controlled study combined with a process evaluation
